



The first class will be Monday, August 21st at St. Joseph hall and on Tuesday, August 22nd at St. Rose of Lima.


BOOK SIGNING BY FATHER FLO!

HOW TO DRESS FOR MASS ATTENDANCE

Modern culture has done a lot to erode away many of our traditions as well as decency and reverence. Although the Catholic Church has no real dress code for proper attire when attending Mass, there *is* an unwritten dress code that demands we are properly dressed out of Respect, Honor, and Reverence for the Real Presence of Our Lord.

There are TWO main reasons one should dress modestly and decently for Mass:

- 1. Out of respect for God.
- 2. In Order not to be a distraction or stumbling block to our fellow parishioners.

It is also a wonderful way to teach our children respect, honor and reverence.

Here is what the Catechism of the Catholic Church has to say about dressing properly for Mass:



"To prepare for worthy reception of this sacrament, the faithful should observe the fast required in their Church. Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of this moment when Christ becomes our guest." – CCC 1387

Generally, we should be guided by a combination of virtue, common sense, and piety when deciding what to wear to Mass.

Modesty must never be sacrificed for comfortability. I will allow shorts for men and women and are to be worn to the knee. The same goes for skirts for women, it should be to the knee or below. Blouses and tops should not be revealing. Again, I encourage you to dress comfortably, tempered by modesty.
