

Faith Formation

Bible Study will be held in the Mary House on Monday, December 11th. There will be no bible study on the morning of Tuesday,

Father Greg will be out on retreat beginning Tuesday, December 12th and will return the afternoon of Tuesday, December 19th.

New gallons of holy water may be brought to church and placed in front of the large Blessed Mother statue by the confessional beginning the day after Christmas and until January 6th. Please label with your name. Father will bless them on the eve of the Epiphany.

Epiphany water is a powerful

weapon against Satan—The Roman Ritual provides a strong blessing of Epiphany water that casts out all evil spirits.

While the feast of Epiphany in the Roman Rite is primarily focused on the visit of the Magi, historically it was more focused on the baptism of Jesus Christ in the Jordan River. For this reason, there developed a special blessing of Epiphany water in



memory of Jesus sanctifying the waters of Baptism.

This blessing of water on Epiphany was maintained by Eastern Catholics, but Roman Catholics also have an optional ceremony that was approved in 1890 that did homage to this tradition.

The emphasis of the blessing, however, was less on the commemoration of Jesus' baptism and more on the **symbolic nature of water as a cleansing agent**. In this way, the blessing of Epiphany water in the Roman Rite was used to cast out Satan and all his demonic angels.

It is a powerful blessing, one that uses strong language to invoke the power of God over evil. It reminds us of the spiritual power of holy water and encourages us to use it in faith, trusting in the protecting help of God over our spiritual enemies. Here is an excerpt of the prayer, which is quite lengthy.
