Beginning in 2024, every first Friday of the month, the 6:30 a.m. Mass intention will be solely for all those who have died in the previous month who were part of the parish, or were buried here, or had a funeral in St. Joseph church.

1st Saturday Mass is February 3rd at 9 a.m. at St. Rose.

The First Saturdays Devotion

The First Saturdays Devotion, also known as the "Five First Saturdays" is a special request by Our Lord and Our Lady to make reparation for all the sins against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady promised personal salvation if we fulfill the five consecutive First Saturdays. However, we should continue to fulfill them every month to console the Hearts of Jesus and Mary and make reparation for the sins of others. The continued practice of the First Saturdays will help bring about a period of peace and the salvation of many souls as Our Lady promised (Fatima, July 13, 1917).

On the First Saturday during 5 Consecutive Months, the Devotion consists of:

1. Going to Confession,
2. Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion
3. Praying five decades of the Rosary
4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

We do this all with the intention to make reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. What does that mean? It means that we try to pull thorns out of Her Immaculate Heart. We try to make atonement and amends for our sins and those sins of our family members and friends.

Our Lord explained to Sr. Lucia how the Five First Saturdays correspond with the five offenses and blasphemies that mankind commits against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

1. Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception
2. Blasphemies against her Virginity
3. Blasphemies against the Divine Maternity, refusing, at the same time, to receive her as the Mother of mankind.
4. Instilling indifference, scorn and even hatred towards this Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children.
5. Direct insults against Her sacred images.

Our Lady pleads for our prayers and we must listen to her, and console the injuries and insults to Her and Her Divine Son. This devotion is a great gift that was given to us not only for reparation, but also to protect our souls in the spiritual battles that we are in every day and at the hour of our death. In the message of Fatima, we stand between the Consecration of Russia, which has been done, and the Conversion of Russia.
