#### Life in Christ:







#### First Confession/First Communion Rehearsal Dress Code

- Children should wear Sunday best (think wedding attire)
  - ^ No shorts! No exceptions!
  - ^ Girls: dresses and jumpsuits/rompers are acceptable, also jeans or capris and a nice blouse (nothing sleeveless, must go to the waist, no crop tops). No graphics or inappropriate writing.
    - Dresses must reach the knee.
    - Jumpsuits/rompers must go to the ankle.
    - Shoes must be Sunday best. Boots are allowed.
      - No tennis shoes.
    - ^ Boys: pants and polo or button down shirts are acceptable.
      - Pants may be khaki, black, navy, or dress jeans (no holes).
         Please wear a belt.
      - Shirts can be any color, but should be church appropriate.
         No graphics or inappropriate writing. The shirt must have a collar.
         No t-shirts.
      - Shoes must be Sunday best. Boots are allowed.
        - No tennis shoes.

#### First Communion Dress Code

^ Girls - White communion dresses with white veil or headpiece, nude stockings, and white dress shoes. Dresses must be mid-calf to floor length. Shoulders MUST be covered, whether by dress, veil, or wrap. Hair may be worn in any fashion, but must be well groomed. Jewelry is allowed, but must be simple: silver or gold with white only (no colored beads or stones). Shoulder wraps, bolero covers, and gloves are allowed, but must be solid white.

NO ALTERNATIVES, NO EXCEPTIONS.

^ Boys - White, <u>long sleeve</u>, button down shirts with black dress pants, <u>solid</u> black tie or bowtie, black belt, black socks, and black dress shoes. Jacket, vest, or sport coat optional; must be <u>solid</u> black. Undershirts are optional, but must be <u>solid</u> white. Hair must be well groomed. NO ALTERNATIVES, NO EXCEPTIONS.

\*\*If you are unsure whether or not the outfit is appropriate, please dress the child in the outfit and send it in a text to 337-230-3549. I will give approval based on the picture.\*\*

- If you have come to register for First Communion or Confirmation and your student is from a Catholic school, please see Mrs. Heidi before you register.
- If you belong to another church parish and are not a parishioner of St. Joseph or St. Rose of Lima, you will either:
  - 1 Need to register as a parishioner of one of our churches and sign up for donation envelopes (YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO REGISTER AS A PARISHIONER TONIGHT), OR
  - 2 Register for Faith Formation in the parish you belong to, if you prefer.

Faith Formation should always take place in your HOME PARISH!






#### **Parent Volunteers**

#### Registration Process - 5 Steps!

Step 1: In the right pocket of your folder, you should have a registration form. Be sure to grab a Parishioner Form and a Payment Schedule Form (you will use only one form per family; the number on your form should go on the bottom of your registration sheet for each child you register; we will keep track of them as well.) Fill everything out!

Step 2: Attach baptism certificate copy. Those without certificate copies will be asked to complete the registration form at home and return to the St. Joseph Office with completed form, certificate copies, and method of payment to complete the registration process.

Step 3: Decide on your payment schedule and fill out your payment slip.

Step 4: Come to the checkout table with your completed forms and payment slip. You can pay with cash, check, card, or through our QR code for Square. Have your payment method ready to go!

Step 5 (optional): Order a T-shirt, if you would like one! Many sizes are available!
