



Saint Vincent DePaul members are visiting and praying with neighbors* in their homes, in our office, and by phone.

- During the months of February, March, and April, we assisted 65 neighbors comprised of 221 family members, with their utilities, rent and miscellaneous expenses. Most of all we visited with them as caring neighbors. We helped our friends without homes with food, hygiene bags, gas cards and, if needed, an overnight hotel stay.
- Our food pantry teams distributed food to 488 people. We appreciate our volunteer food pantry staff who pick up food from the Capitol Area Food Bank and restock the pantry shelves.
- Thanks to the families who deliver bags of food to seniors at Onion Creek Village and to the American Heritage Girls for donations of diapers, paper products, detergent, and hygiene items. Our society is blessed by the support of these groups and Father Jesse and Father Sam. We are very grateful to the parish community for their donations.
- Please continue to pray for us as we grow spiritually by our service to our neighbors.

*The people we serve we call our neighbors--not clients. The term "neighbor" is important because we consider those we serve as our equals, our friends, and in important ways, our teachers.






