We have begun the roll out of our *Come To The Table* campaign! Yard signs will be available this Sunday to take and display at your home. Please remember that there is a limited number. So please take one per household.

The July 26 issue of *The Church Today* will focus on our *Come To The Table* campaign, with graphics and different articles. These will be in mailboxes throughout that week. Every Thursday through November a new video will be posted to the Diocesan Facebook page featuring testimonials from parishioners from across the Diocese.

This campaign is a way to invite our Catholics to begin attending Mass again if they are able.
