In September 2015, over 3,800 adult members of our parish completed a parishioner engagement survey, the ME25. The results showed that about one-third of our parishioners are "engaged" in parish life – these are people ready, willing and able to respond to God's call. While this compares favorably to the national Catholic average of 16%, we have lots of room to grow. So, 120 of our ministry leaders gathered and identified 4 key areas of engagement to focus on as a parish family:

CONNECT: Someone in the parish has talked to me about my spiritual growth.

LOVE: I have received recognition or praise from someone in my parish.




