

# Good News Reflection

**Pray:** Forgive me, Father, for the apathy I showed in so many suffering situations. I repent of this and I commit myself to seek strength in Your love and mercy and to get involved wherever I see pain and need. **Amen.** 

#### **ENOUGH LOVE TO HEAL THE WORLD**

The opposite of love is not hate. It's apathy: ignoring a need, not caring, and doing nothing when there is something we can do to relieve suffering. In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus gives us the Parable of the Good Samaritan to explain that if we love God with our whole heart, our whole being, our whole strength, and our whole mind, we naturally care about other people, even those who are strangers, even those whom we're "not supposed to" like, and even when it costs us something personally.

Many of the problems that exist in our world today are allowed to continue because too many of us Christians — we who through Christ have the power to change the world — do not care enough to sacrifice our time and personal agendas to get involved. Much of the suffering that's endured in our families and workplaces and parishes would be stopped or relieved if enough Christians loved God enough to care about others enough to risk the cost of intervening.

How much do you love God? The answer lies in how much you're willing to sacrifice for the sake of loving others, which is the definition of love that Jesus taught us with this parable and with his life.

None of us love God perfectly yet. Purgatory will be a time of painfully regretting our lack of love, while eagerly improving our love for others so we can enter into the fullness of God's love in heaven. Until then, we have daily opportunities, here and now, to purify our lives less painfully. Daily we're given tests to improve how well we love others.

So daily ask the Holy Spirit, your teacher, your empowerer, your source of holiness, to help you become more like Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you love all others as Christ loves them.

By doing this spiritual exercise consistently, you will receive a new joy and an enlivened passion in dealing with others. You will feel greater love for God and you will experience his love for you much more intimately.

#### **Questions for Personal Reflection:**

Whom do you pass by and ignore when you see suffering? Is there anyone you've recently walked away from because you didn't want to give up something (perhaps your time, pride, prejudice, feeling of inadequacy,

resentment or unforgiveness)? Take it to the Sacrament of Confession to receive God's grace and help in loving others more fully.

#### **Questions for Family & Community Faith Sharing:**

Name a "Good Samaritan" you know or have read about. What did this person give up to serve others? How do such people find the ability to love so well? Describe a situation you've witnessed where apathy has contributed to someone's suffering. How could love make a difference?



#### MINSTRY HIGHLIGHT: MINISTRY WITH PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

This week we highlight our Ministry with Persons with Disabilities. This ministry seeks to serve parishioners who may need special accommodations due to a disability.

The CDC recently reported that 26% of adults in the United States have some type of disability. Almost 8% of the children in the U.S. have a disability. This rise in occurrence is a trend that is predicted to continue. The goal of the Ministry with Persons with Disabilities is to facilitate lifelong faith formation, access to the graces and sacraments of the Church, and total parish participation for every Catholic with physical, behavioral, emotional or cognitive disabilities.

St. Laurence is aware of the growing needs of our parishioners with disabilities and is committed to accommodating parishioners so that they can be active members in our parish. St. Laurence has expanded its religious education offerings to include children and teens of differing abilities. This ministry thrives on the support of the parish community without whom, our work is not possible. Our ministry is made up of concerned individuals from our parish, as well as those with disabilities themselves, and those caring for a child or adult with a disability. God equips those who are called to serve.

I did not choose St. Laurence, St. Laurence chose me. Nothing I had previously experienced prepared me for the amazing outpouring of the Spirit that was the St.

Laurence Life Teen Mass and we joined the parish in 2003. In our previous parish, we had been active in ministry, but when we moved to St. Laurence I became even more involved because the parish was very multicultural and there were a lot more opportunities for service and participation. For newcomers, migrants, and refugees, being part of a ministry can be life-saving. When you serve others, you forget your own troubles, build new relationships, and acquire a new family connected by love, not by blood, partners in the journey. In addition to helping with Youth Ministry, Adoration, Hispanic Ministry, and at Mass as a Lector and Extraordinary Minister, our family started a prayer group for Venezuelans living outside their country, Parroquia Virtual Venezolana. We do this as a family and as a couple, which has helped us grow together. We also do it as a community, with other Venezuelan musicians, sharing our culture and traditions to connect and help people know who we are and where we come from. Life changes, and so will your ministries, so try different things until you find that service where you can share your gifts. Because sharing will make you grow in unexpected ways.
