PARISH SCHOOL & CHAPEL


St. Laurence Catholic School provides strong academics in a Christian environment to 720 students enrolled in PreK4 through Grade 8.

- Call the parish office during business hours (281-980-9812)
- The sick person must be a parishioner of St. Laurence
- Request must come directly from the person (or a close family member, such as spouse or parent)
- Ask for your name to be added to the PRAY FOR THE SICK list
- Your name will appear on the list for 4 weeks
- Need prayer longer than 4 weeks? Simply call back and your name will be added for another 4 week period

Not a parishioner?

Ask for the name to be added to the Book of the Sick. Anyone in need of prayers for healing may have their name written in the Book of the Sick. These intentions are prayed for at every Mass. The Book of the Sick is located near the statue of St. Joseph in the church. You may write the name in the book yourself, or if you are not able to come to the church, we are happy to do it for you.

Almighty God, as we ask your help for our brothers and sisters who are ill, we ask you to help us to be healing people in our time and place. May your love touch others through us, and may we help all people to live in peace. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.


