Adjacent to the school is the Chapel of the Divine Mercy which offers Perpetual Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and serves as the site for smaller liturgies.

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

This Sunday marks a special day for those on their journey to entrance into the Catholic Church through the OCIA (formerly RCIA) process.



During the Rite of Sending at the 9 a.m. Mass, our parish community will send the Candidates and Catechumens in the process to the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart for the Rite of Election of Catechumens and Calling the Candidates to Continuing Conversion. At this rite, Cardinal DiNardo will give his blessing to them as they prepare to enter the church this Easter. Please keep them in your prayers as they go through this final period, known as Purification and Enlightenment. You can see more of what their journey entails by looking at the map on page 5 of this bulletin.

This process, now known as the Order (formerly Rite) of Christian Initiation of Adults, has undergone some recent updates in the United States. The intention in changing the title of the process from "Rite" to "Order" indicates that this is truly an incremental process with several periods and rites, and not simply a single event. Additionally, there have been some minor updates in the translation to more closely align with the Latin original and offer more precise theological understanding.

This process, originally known as the Catechumenate in the ancient church, was where adult converts underwent a structured process of initiation. After the Second Vatican Council, this powerful process for facilitating conversion was brought back and adapted for the needs of our modern era. The effectiveness of this process is rooted in the three aspects of its liturgical, catechetical, and pastoral nature. The beauty of the liturgical rites of this process, along with the transformative teaching of the truths of the Catholic Faith, and the incremental facilitation of one's personal conversion to Jesus Christ all combine to transform lives in OCIA. You can find out more details about the Church's process for drawing people into relationship with Christ and the Church by scanning the QR code on this page. These updates are an excellent opportunity for our parish community to recommit ourselves to sharing in the Church's evangelizing mission. Perhaps this is the time for you to invite someone to consider growing in their relationship with Christ, to join the OCIA process, or for you to personally join the OCIA Team when we start up again in the fall!
