

OME BACK TO ME

I woke up Ash Wednesday with the song "Hosea" reverberating in my head; then at Mass, it was the opening hymn. Lent is a time of purification and illumination. God is calling each of us back to Him.

Long have I waited for your coming home to me and living deeply our new life.

Each and every Lent we have an opportunity to go deeper. To live my life with Him, within. To move closer to our Lord. One of the most profound ways we move towards Him is through prayer.

Where do you pray? Scripture tells us: But when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you. My inner room is my soul, where Christ resides. But for me, the best place to physically close the door is the Chapel of Divine Mercy in Perpetual Adoration. I go there and see Jesus in the Eucharist. I sit in quiet contemplation and just gaze upon Him with love. His love, returned to me, illuminates my soul.

This is the season of Lent and repentance. My Lord calls me to the chapel to contemplate my life and see where virtue has been lacking. Perhaps a thorough examination of conscience is needed? Then I go make a most complete reconciliation and receive absolution. Or perhaps I am to read the gospel while I am there? When we received ashes, we were reminded: Repent and believe in the gospel.

My rosary ends with, O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy mercy. Amen. Perhaps I have been called to Adoration to pray the rosary for others as I kneel before Jesus? Or perhaps I need to make a sacrifice of prayer in reparation for all those times when I did not trust in Jesus?

Lent is not something that we do in isolation. We come together in community, willing everyone to move closer to the Lord. Jesus said to us: For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.







MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: ADORATION MINISTRY

Adoration Ministry prays for our families, our church, and our world before our Lord who is present before our very eyes in the Blessed Sacrament. The prayer is done in silence however He calls you to pray. Some pray the rosary, some pray the divine mercy chaplet, some talk to our Lord, and some sit in silent adoration. Some use their hour to immerse themselves in the word by reading scripture in the presence of the Word. It can be a time to praise, a time to give thanks, a time to petition Him. He is there always to help you discern the direction in your life.

The Ministry has over 400 active members. Two persons pray each hour of the day, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. By committing to a regular weekly hour of Adoration or being a regular substitute the opportunity for prayer before His Presence is available to all in the church. Not only our parishioners but our community of saints from all over Sugar Land come to pray before Him. Visitors from afar also stop in to pray.

"How can we come to know Christ," he asked? How can we come to know the love of Christ which surpasses all knowledge"? (Eph 3:14)






