

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead . . . (Philippians 3:13)

St. Paul's description of his life in Christ can sound like a burdensome set of rules: accept the loss of all things; share in Jesus' sufferings; forget what lies behind; strain toward God's upward calling.

But Paul was happy to do all of this. Why? Because he had been changed.

He had encountered Jesus, experienced his mercy, and was convinced that his new life was infinitely better! The imprint of Paul's experience of conversion on the road to Damascus, and every choice he made to follow Jesus thereafter, transformed his perspective. The entire direction of his life was different.

You can imagine something similar happening in the heart of the woman caught in adultery in today's Gospel reading. Her sin was laid bare before Jesus, and she was about to be killed by an angry mob. But she received God's unexpected and surprising mercy as Jesus dispersed the crowd and said to her, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more" (John 8:11). Surely, empowered by Jesus' words, she gladly accepted the loss of her old way of life, just as Paul had. She was happy to forget the emptiness of what lay behind her and, by God's grace, to strain toward his upward calling of a life free from her past sins.

How have you encountered Jesus? You might have decided to give your life completely to him at a pivotal point. You might have brought a burdensome sin to Confession and been convinced of God's forgiveness and love. Maybe you're longing for an even deeper encounter right now!

These experiences can change your heart and shape your perspective. They make losing your life for Jesus—even when it involves difficulty—completely worth it! You, like Paul, can hold onto the "supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus [your] Lord" (Philippians 3:8).

"Jesus, I will follow you!"



REGISTER NOW

Registration is open now for the 2025-2026 (SEPT-MAY) formation year for children ages 3 through high school. Here at St. Laurence, we offer a period of 2 month to register – April and May. This allows you to register your children early, before the distraction of summer activities and family vacations. Additionally, an Advance Pricing incentive is being offered for families who register in April. On May 1, registration fees go up \$20 during the Regular Pricing period, which ends June 1. This includes programs for PreK and Elementary CCE, Edge, Life Teen, Family Faith and Sacrament Preparation.

SACRAMENTS

Preparation for Reconciliation/First Eucharist and Confirmation is a 2-year process. YEAR 1: Enroll your child in CCE (or Catholic school) in 1st grade so that he/she may receive First Sacraments in 2nd grade. YEAR 2: Enroll your child in CCE (or Catholic school) in 2nd grade AND enroll your child in First Sacraments. For 9th graders, the process is similar, with a first year of Life Teen and a second year of Life Teen AND Confirmation.



MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT:

DIVINE MERCY MINISTRY

The Divine Mercy Ministry is a guided study program that includes the Diary of St. Faustina, the Sacred Scriptures and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The Ministry touched by these private revelations of (Jesus to St. Faustina) put into action the spiritual and corporal works of Mercy. This includes yearly Conferences, Divine Mercy Devotions on Divine Mercy Sunday, and Good Friday.

The apostolate nurtures the genuine belief in the Real Presence of Our Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist, promotes Eucharistic Adoration, together with hourly praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet for the sick and dying. This Ministry is under the umbrella of the Marians of the Immaculate Conception and the Eucharistic Apostles of the Divine Mercy (EADM) who provide shipments of medical and educational materials to the poor and imprisoned worldwide.

St. Laurence has two Divine Mercy Cenacles: Thursday mornings at 10am in the St. Francis Room at the Ave Maria Center (contact: Sally Flowers 281-265-8360) or our Cenacle in Spanish on Friday mornings at 10am via Zoom (contact: Rebecca Yanes 605-660-7611).

APR 18: GOOD FRIDAY AT ST. LAURENCE

On Good Friday, we read, hear and pray the Passion of Our Lord. Our tradition at St. Laurence is to WEAR RED to the Solemn Good Friday Liturgies at 3pm and 7pm. Brochure of the Month: Raising Chaste Children in a Pornographic World.

One of the more difficult jobs of a parent is to educate their children on sexuality. Many parents feel very awkward about broaching the subject, but children want direction and guidance. Update (not from the brochure): Pornography peddlers are deliberately marketing to young children. The sooner they begin looking, the sooner they can become addicted. While filtering software on cell phones may be helpful, it is not sufficient. 
