# ALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

#### Jesus proceeded on his journey up to Jerusalem. (Luke 19:28)

Today we begin the holiest week of our Church year. We join the crowds and shout, "Hosanna!" as Jesus enters Jerusalem. We listen to him teach. even while people plot to kill him. We see him wash his disciples' feet and offer them his Body and Blood, despite knowing that one will betray him and the rest will abandon him. We



watch as he is rejected by his people and handed over to death on a cross.

It's easy to see Jesus just as an unfortunate, tragic victim of hatred and violence—and he was. But he was more than that. He freely chose to embrace his passion and death. He freely chose to offer himself as a sacrifice for our salvation. He offered no resistance to his captors, like the Suffering Servant who "gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard" (Isaiah 50:6).

This week, we have the chance to accompany Jesus as he makes his way to the cross. He invites us to give him thanks and praise for his mighty deeds. He invites us to receive his Body and Blood that he freely poured out for us. And he invites us to stay awake with him, to "get up and pray that you may not undergo the test" (Luke 22:46).

Like the disciples, we may not do this perfectly. But just as Jesus freely chose to offer himself for us, we can freely choose to stay close to him. We can read his word and recall all he did for us. We can sit before the Lord in prayer and participate in the liturgies of the Triduum. We can try our best to love the people around us as Jesus loved us. And if we fail, we can receive the mercy he offers from the cross: "Father, forgive them" (Luke 23:34).

"Thank you, Lord, for suffering for me. Help me to remain close to vou this week."



# **FAITH FORMATION FOR YOUR FAMILY**

Together, we can help your family grow in knowledge & understanding of our Catholic Faith, enjoy a rich Sacramental life, learn ways to pray, grow in virtue, cultivate healthy relationships and serve others.



#### **REGISTER NOW**

#### stlaurence.org/registration

Registration is open now for the 2025-2026 (SEPT-MAY) formation year for children ages 3 through high school. Here at St. Laurence, we offer a period of 2 months to register – April and May. This allows you to register your children early, before the distraction of summer activities and family vacations. Additionally, an Advance Pricing incentive is being offered for families who register in April. On May 1, registration fees go up \$20 during the Regular Pricing period, which ends June 1. This includes programs for PreK and Elementary CCE, Edge, Life Teen, Family Faith and Sacrament Preparation.

#### **SACRAMENTS**

#### stlaurence.org/registration

Preparation for Reconciliation/First Eucharist and Confirmation is a 2-year process. YEAR 1: Enroll your child in CCE (or Catholic school) in 1st grade so that he/she may receive First Sacraments in 2nd grade. YEAR 2: Enroll your child in CCE (or Catholic school) in 2nd grade AND enroll your child in First Sacraments. For 9th graders, the process is similar, with a first year of Life Teen and a second year of Life Teen AND Confirmation.
