EXPECTATIONS OF A LIFE TEEN SMALL GROUP LEADER

- 1. Provide Food or snacks to the students at Sunday Life Nights
- 2. Prepare food and drinks to be served before the students arrive
- 3. Help clean up after the snack time
- 4. Greet all students with a smile and kindness
- 5. Be able to answer questions and provide information about Life Teen
- 6. Commits to a healthy relationship with Youth Ministry at St. Laurence Catholic Church, including Core members, the Pastor and administrators, parents, and youth.

BEST PRACTICES OF A SMALL GROUP LEADER

- Check in with a youth minister or receptionist at the reception desk of the Ave Maria Center upon arrival
- Wash hands in hand washing sink in the kitchen for 20 seconds or more
- Put on a pair of gloves. Replace the gloves as needed.
- Recycle if able/possible
- When snack/mealtime is over, help clean up and put things away
- Place any trash bags that are full in the gray bin near the back door of the kitchen
- Return unused plates, cups, and napkins to the cabinets in the kitchen
- Wipe down and sanitize tables
- Smile and greet the students that you are serving ©
- Remember and call people by their names as much as possible
- Help guide any parents or teens who look lost & confused upon checking in
- Report back to youth minister or receptionist before leaving
- Notify the High School Coordinator if you are unable to serve at a Life Night
