REPORTS TO:

St. Laurence Catholic Church Coordinator of High School Faith Formation, and, as applicable, the Confirmation Coordinator

QUALIFICATIONS

- Baptized and Confirmed practicing Roman Catholic, which includes weekly Sunday Mass and regular Confession in the Sacrament of Reconciliation
- In-person meeting with the High School Coordinator (and once a year thereafter)
- 90-minute Safe Environment Course (Link provided after initial in-person meeting)
- Bi-annual Core team training at the start and mid-way through the year
- Signed Volunteer Acknowledgement, Code of Conduct, and Handbook

EXPECTATIONS OF A LIFE TEEN SMALL GROUP LEADER

- 1. Maintains an active relationship with Christ and the Church
- 2. Creates a safe and welcoming environment for teens in your small group
- 3. Prepares for & leads a 30–40-minute small group session at our parish's weekly Sunday night High School Program (Life Teen)
- 4. Connects with, knows, and cares for teens in their small groups and encourages them to do the same with each other
- 5. Commits to healthy relationships with Youth Ministry at St. Laurence Catholic Church, including Core members, youth ministers, Pastor, administrators, parents, and youth

BEST PRACTICES OF A SMALL GROUP LEADER

- Pray regularly for the students in your small group
- Maintain presence, have your attention focused on the students of your small group
- Talk with and build relationships with your small group during dinner
- Sit with teens during large group and participate during the ice breakers
- Remember what students share and follow up with them (For example: if they share they had a test, sporting event, recital, etc. ask them how it went next time you see them.)
- Share prayer requests and program feedback with the Coordinators
- Chaperone and/or lead small group on retreats, conferences, and camps when able to
- Plan ahead and be prepared for each small group meeting using the outline, scripture passages and catechism paragraphs emailed in advance
- Those wanting the outlines before the Wednesday email will have access to series plans at the beginning of each semester
- Assist with large group sessions as planned by the High School Coordinator
- Notify the High School Coordinator if you are unable to serve at a Life Night
