Candidate and Sponsor Dress Code for the Rite of Confirmation

Men (both youth and sponsor) must wear the following:

- Dress pants or slacks (no jeans)
- Solid colored button-down shirt with collar; must be tucked in- no t-shirts or polos
- Jacket/sports coat/blazer is preferred but not required
- Tie or bowtie preferred but not required
- Hairstyle that does not cover the forehead

Women (both youth and sponsor) must wear the following:

- Dress, skirt, or dress pants (no jeans or leggings)
- Dress or skirt must reach at least the knee cap
- Chest, back, mid-riff/stomach, waist, hips, cleavage, and shoulders must be covered (if not covered, jacket or sweater must be worn)
- No spaghetti straps, sleeveless, strapless, backless, low-cut, see-through, too tight, or off the shoulder
- Armholes should be sized appropriately and not oversized
- Hairstyle that does not cover the forehead
- If wearing heels, make sure they are not too tall to walk-in

If you are questioning if something is modest or not, perform this easy test: Sit, Bend and Reach. Sit to see if your dress too short. Bend over in front of a mirror to see if your shirt is too low cut. Reach your hands up to see if it's too tight. If it is, it will not be allowed.
