

St. Laurence Confirmation Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation?

- The St. Laurence Catholic Church Confirmation preparation program is open to 10th, 11th or 12th graders who have been baptized and are already active and registered members of St. Laurence Catholic Church. This means they have completed at least one year of our parish's High School program (Life Teen) alongside all 9-12 grade students.

Does the Confirmation candidate have to attend the Life Teen high school program every Sunday?

- Yes. Those preparing for Confirmation are to be involved members of St. Laurence, which as high school students, includes attending You were registered for and attended one of our High School faith formation programs (Life Teen, Family Faith, Home Study) and/or attended a Catholic High School for 2025-2026 school year. Those that are absent for four or more Sunday evenings (2 per semester) will need to participate in an exit interview and assessment.

Do we have to attend the Confirmation Information meeting on Monday September 14, 2026?

- Yes. This meeting is required to begin preparation for Confirmation. The teen candidate must attend with at least one parent or legal guardian. If one parent cannot attend, please send another adult with your teen on your behalf. All teens preparing for Confirmation

must attend an information meeting with a parent, legal guardian or trusted adult.

Is the Confirmation Retreat required?

- Yes. The Confirmation Retreat for St. Laurence will be held December 4-6, 2026. Please contact the St. Laurence Confirmation Coordinator Rachel Alcocer at ralcocer@stlaurence.org if you have a conflict.

Note: If our date conflicts with your schedule, it will be your responsibility to find another Confirmation retreat at a different parish and make arrangements.

Is there an ‘at-home’ option to prepare my teen for Confirmation?

- No, there is not. Due to communal aspects of Confirmation, youth within the parish should be prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation together.

Are service projects needed?

- Yes. All candidates must participate in acts of service within the St. Laurence community. One option for consideration is: Night of the Living Saints. Candidates can choose from one of these two dates:
 - November 4, 2026 or January 27, 2027 from 7:00 PM- 8:00 PM
