

Dear Parishioners,

Throughout the year, different months are dedicated to different truths of our faith like Our Lord, the Blessed Mother, a Saint, etc. The month of November is dedicated to the Souls in Purgatory. During this month of November, the church reminds us that we should be praying for the souls in Purgatory. I will be remembering all the souls of those you have listed on your All Souls envelopes. Let us remember to pray every day for the Souls in Purgatory, especially those in most need of our prayers.

The rules of obtaining plenary indulgence:

- State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act
- Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
- Confession (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
- Communion (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
- Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)
- Indulgenced Act - a special good work with special conditions of place and time

Indulgenced acts to be performed for obtaining a plenary indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory:

- From November 1-8: visit a cemetery each day with mental prayer for the Souls in Purgatory
- On November 2nd: visit a church or an oratory with the recitation of one Our Father and one Creed

A partial indulgence can be obtained any time by visiting a cemetery and praying for the Souls in Purgatory.

The following prayer is especially recommended:

*Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domine, et lux perpetua  
luceat eis. Requiescant in pace. Amen*

*Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine  
upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.*

**On November 2nd at 6:30 pm., we will have a special Mass for those from our Parish who passed away during this past year. We will also have a Mass every weekday evening (Monday thru Friday) at 6:30 pm through November 8th for the deceased.**

## Saint of the Day

### Nov 1 - *All Saints*

All Saints' Day is a celebration of all Catholic saints held on November 1 each year. "On this solemnity, we recall the holy men and women who, having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. These saints, though not canonized, offer us models of abiding faith and love of God and neighbor" (Essential Guide to Seasons and Saints, 109).

### Nov 3 - *Saint Martin de Porres*

Martin de Porres was born in Lima, Peru, of Spanish and black parentage. Inheriting his mother's dark color, at times he was looked down upon by his aristocratic father, and, in early childhood, he was badly neglected. Martin began developing his prayer life at an early age. He had a deep devotion to our Lord's Passion, and continually prayed to know what he could do in gratitude for the immense blessings of the Redemption. The appeal of St. Martin de Porres is universal. Called an apostle of charity; patron of social justice; father of the sick and the poor; wonder worker of Peru; and helper in hopeless cases, he is a powerful intercessor to those in need.

### Nov 4 - *Saint Charles Borromeo*

Charles Borromeo was the Archbishop of Milan from 1564 to 1584 and a cardinal of the Catholic Church. He was a leading figure of the Counter-Reformation combat against the Protestant Reformation together with Ignatius of Loyola and Philip Neri. In that role he was responsible for significant reforms in the Catholic Church, including the founding of seminaries for the education of priests. Charles Borromeo is the patron saint of bishops, catechists and seminarians.


