# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

*The most Blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin.*

In 1854, Pope Pius IX's solemn declaration, "Ineffabilis Deus," clarified with finality the long-held belief of the church that Mary was conceived free from original sin. Mary was granted this extraordinary privilege because of Her unique role in history as the Mother of God. That is, she received the gift of salvation in Christ from the very moment of her conception.

Even though Mary is unique in all humanity for being born without sin, she is held up by the Church as a model for all humanity in her holiness and her purity in her willingness to accept the Plan of God for her.

Every person is called to recognize and respond to God's call to their own vocation in order to carry out God's plan for their life and fulfill the mission prepared for them since before the beginning of time. Mary's "Let it be done to me according to Thy Word," in response of the Angel Gabriel's greeting, is the response required of all Christians to God's Plan.

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is a time to celebrate the great joy of God's gift to humanity in Mary, and to recognize with greater clarity, the truth that each and every human being has been created by God to fulfill a particular mission that he and only he can fulfill.

Our schedule for the Immaculate Conception is:

- Tuesday, December 7th: Vigil Mass at 4:15 p.m.
- Wednesday, December 8th: Masses at 8 a.m and 6:30 p.m.

Please come to celebrate this beautiful Solemnity.

**Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception****Patroness of the United States of America - December 8**

"No sin would touch her, so that she would be a fitting and worthy vessel of the Son of God. The Immaculate Conception does not refer to the virginal conception and the birth of Christ, but rather to Mary's being conceived without inheriting Original Sin."

*(United States Catholic Catechism for Adults, 142-143)*

On this Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, a holy day of obligation, attend Mass and pray the Hail Mary before meals.

## Saint of the Day

### Dec 6 - *St. Nicholas*

St. Nicholas, also known as "Nikolaos of Myra," was a fourth century saint and Greek bishop of Myra. Both of his parents tragically died during an epidemic when he was a young man, leaving him well off, but to be raised by his uncle, the Bishop of Patara. Nicholas was determined to devote his inheritance to works of charity, and his uncle mentored him as a reader and later ordained him as a presbyter (priest). He was generous to the poor, and special protector of the innocent and wronged.

### Dec 7 - *St. Ambrose*

One of the four original doctors of the Church. He was the Bishop of Milan and became one of the most important theological figures of the 4th century. St. Ambrose was generous to the poor; he considered it repayment of God's resources, which were intended for everyone equally. He introduced reforms in the order and manner of public worship, and is credited with advising to follow local liturgical customs. "When I am at Rome, I fast on a Saturday; when I am at Milan, I do not..." he stated. This advice remains today, and is translated as the saying, "When in Rome, do as the Romans do." Ambrose authored many of the Church's important writings and hymns.

### Dec 8 - *The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary*

A Catholic feast celebrating Mary's conception without sin. Even though this feast day occurs in the liturgical season of Advent, which prepares for the birth of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, the Immaculate Conception refers to the conception of Mary in the womb of her mother, St. Anne.

### Dec 9 - *St. Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin*

A native to Mexico, he became the first Roman Catholic indigenous saint from the Americas. It was to Juan Diego that Mary, the Mother of God, first introduced herself to the world as Our Lady of Guadalupe. After the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Juan Diego received permission to live as a hermit and spent the rest of his life in prayer and penance. Greatly esteemed and known for his holiness, he devoted himself to the pilgrims who came to see the miraculous image of Mary imprinted on his cloak.

### Dec 11 - *Saint Damasus I*

During his time as Pope he called the Second Ecumenical Council, explained the true faith and greatly encouraged love of the Scriptures. He published the canon, or official list, of the books of the Bible. Because of his faith and love he was able to do great things for the Church. He is commended for his zeal for the purity of the Faith, the innocence of his manners, his Christian humility, his compassion for the poor, and his piety.

## Year of St. Joseph December 8, 2020 thru December 8, 2021

What does it mean for a person to be consecrated to St. Joseph? It means that you acknowledge that he is your spiritual father, and you want to be like him. To show it, you entrust yourself entirely into his paternal care so that he can help you acquire his virtues and become holy. Total consecration to St. Joseph means you make a formal act of filial entrustment to your spiritual father so that he can take care of your spiritual well-being and lead you to God. The person who consecrates himself to St. Joseph wants to be as close to their spiritual father as possible, to the point of resembling him in virtue and holiness.

Saint Joseph, in turn, will give those consecrated to him his undivided attention, protection, and guidance.



### PRAYER OF CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH




