From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

February 2nd - the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord - deserves more attention than just being the absolute final day for Christmas decorations. We celebrate the blessing of the candles for the year, Candlemas, on February 2nd.

After celebrating the Nativity of our Lord, with its splendor in the Church, it would be easy for one's mind to drift and overlook the significance of the fortieth day after the Lord's birth.

Joseph and Mary's presentation of the baby was no pro forma event. The words of the prophet Malachi are fulfilled in the poor parents presenting their firstborn son along with their humble sacrifice of two turtledoves. The mother of God - the Theotokos (the name used in the Eastern Orthodox Church for the Virgin Mary) - in no need of ritual purification, and her husband did not set themselves above the Law.

In their conformation to the Law is God's entrance into his Temple. Simeon and Anna, pious and elderly, having spent their lives in prayer and waiting in the Temple for the Messiah, have their "moment." There is the glorious Nunc Dimittis of Simeon (also known as the Song or Canticle of Simeon).

With Candlemas we celebrate the coming of the Light of the World. But a shadow also passes; a shadow foretelling the suffering that will precede the victory of the Light over darkness. Simeon not only proclaimed that he had seen his salvation, but also told the Mother of our Lord that her share would include a sorrow-pierced heart. In Redemptoris Mater, Pope John Paul II wrote that Mary heard in Simeon's words something akin to a second Annunciation, "for they tell her of the actual historical situation in which the Son is to accomplish his mission, namely, in misunderstanding and sorrow."

What shall we ask of the Lord as we celebrate his Presentation? For a moment meditate on this and give Him an answer.

And please join us for the celebration of Mass on Wednesday, February 2nd at 8:00 a.m. and 6:30pm and bring your candle(s) for a blessing.

Saint of the Day

Jan 31 - St. John Bosco

Born in Italy in 1815, John was raised primarily by his mother, regularly attended church and became very devout. He helped his family grow food and raise sheep and despite their poverty they found enough to share with the homeless. In 1835, John entered the seminary and following six years of study and preparation, he was ordained a priest in 1841. His first assignment was to the city of Turin. The city was in the throes of industrialization so it had slums and widespread poverty. It was into these poor neighborhoods that Fr. Bosco went to work with the children of the poor. While visiting the prisons, he noticed a large number of boys, between the ages of 12 and 18, inside. The conditions were deplorable, and he felt moved to do more to help other boys from ending up there. He went into the streets and started to meet and share his message with young men and boys where they worked and played. When he was not preaching, Fr. Bosco worked tirelessly seeking work for boys who needed it, and searching for lodgings for others. He is one of the pioneers of Mutual Aid Societies that were initiated as collaborative financial support to young migrant Catholic Workers in the city of Turin. In 1859, Fr. Bosco established the Society of St. Francis de Sales. St. John Bosco was canonized on Easter Sunday, 1934 and he was given the title, "Father and Teacher of Youth."

Feb 2 - The Presentation of the Lord

Forty days after the birth of Jesus Christ, on February 2nd, this was the event in which Our Lady followed Jewish custom and went to the Temple in Jerusalem to present her Son to God. It is also known as Candlemas Day, the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ, the "Light of the World."

Feb 3 - St. Blaise

Saint Blaise is a bishop and martyr who lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. For a time, Blaise lived in a cave to escape persecution. On his feast the church recalls a miracle cure associated with him and celebrates the blessing of the throats. Blaise apparently saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone. The saint said that anyone who lit a candle in his memory would be free of infection, thus candles are used in the traditional throat blessing. He is listed among the Fourteen Holy Helpers, saints revered as healers. He is the patron saint of throat illnesses, animals, wool combers, and wool trading.

St. Ansgar

Ansgar was born of a noble family near Amiens, France. He became a monk at Old Corbie monastery in Picardy and later at New Corbie in Westphalia, Germany. He accompanied King Harald to Denmark when the exiled King returned to his native land and engaged in missionary work there. St. Ansgar was Archbishop of Hamburg-Bremen in the northern part of the Kingdom of the East Franks. Ansgar became known as the "Apostle of the North" because of his travels and the See of Hamburg received the missionary mandate to bring Christianity to Northern Europe.

Feb 5 - St. Agatha

As with other early Christian martyrs, the details of Agatha's story are based on Christian tradition and legend. The Sicilianborn virgin was martyred during the persecution of Emperor Decius, who ruled from 249-51. She was sent to a brothel in an attempt to force her to repudiate her vow of chastity, but she remained steadfast. Amid this ordeal, her breasts were cut off. Healed when St. Peter appeared to her in prison, she died a few days later from further torture. Popular devotion to Agatha soon spread, and she was added to the Roman Canon of the Mass in about 600.




