# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

We easily remember that October is the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary, May the month dedicated to our Blessed Mother, June to the Sacred Heart.

Monthly dedications don't stop there. But for a number of recent years we have let slip such months as February. Who or what is February dedicated to, you ask?

The answer comes at the beginning, on Feb. 2, when we see the Holy Family go to the temple for the Presentation of Jesus. The family is together. The Holy Family.

There's the answer.

But how much do we remember or hear that today? This February we should restore that devotion. It would both honor the Holy Family and at the same time become a reminder to strengthen family life. After all, the Church has taught how The Holy Family is the model, the example, for all families. So said St. John Paul II in a 2001 Angelus, as he called "the family of Nazareth a model for every home." "The Holy Family is the beginning of countless other holy families," John Paul II said earlier in his Letter to Families. He stressed, "The history of mankind, the history of salvation, passes by way of the family." In fact, the saintly pope made it plain that he was trying "to show how the family is placed at the center of the great struggle between good and evil, between life and death, between love and all that is opposed to love." Don't we need to honor and imitate the Holy Family in today's culture and society which attacks families in so many ways? We know why, too.

Sister Lucia wrote, "The final battle between the Lord and the kingdom of Satan will be about Marriage and the Family. Don't be afraid...because whoever works for the sanctity of Marriage and the Family will always be fought against and opposed in every way, because this is the decisive issue."

Remember, too, that the Holy Family was the first domestic church. Again the saintly Pope reminded that "the Fathers of the Church, in the Christian tradition, have spoken of the family as a 'domestic church', a 'little church.'"

We should call upon the Blessed Mother that through her heavenly aid "may each Christian family really become a 'little Church' in which the mystery of the Church of Christ is mirrored and given new life."

Honoring the Holy Family throughout February - and continuing beyond the month - and beginning to imitate them in our own families, we will, as John Paul II told us in his Letter to Families, "come to appreciate the grandeur of the goods of marriage, family, and life; so that [we] will come to appreciate the great danger which follows when these realities are not respected, or when the supreme values which lie at the foundation of the family and of human dignity are disregarded."

Let's honor the Holy Family, imitate them, and consecrate our families to the Holy Family.

Decade-A-Day Rosary Group  
Prayer Intentions

For the month of February we pray for all young children who lose a parent or parents; may God provide the care and guidance they need to become loving and productive adults.

### Why is St. Valentine's feast day not on the Church's calendar?

In the Roman Rite, February 14 is no longer the feast of St. Valentine, even though popular culture celebrates Valentine's Day. The general calendar states that February 14 is the memorial of "Sts. Cyril and Methodius." While nearly the entire Western world celebrates "St. Valentine," the Church directs our attention to a pair of obscure Slavic saints. Why is that? Historically speaking, February 14 has been associated with St. Valentine for centuries, dating back to some of the earliest calendars of the Catholic Church. However, there is not just a single St. Valentine, but 22 saints by the name Valentine - and from many nationalities and of different backgrounds; bishops, martyrs, priests, and even an army officer! The St. Valentine we celebrate with our sweethearts was a 3rd-century Roman priest who was martyred for his Christian faith. There exist a number of legends that surround this particular saint, one of them claiming that he secretly wed couples. His feast day was February 14th, until 1969, when the Second Vatican Council removed some Saints from the general calendar. St. Paul VI later explained in his *motu proprio, Mysteriorum Paschalis*, why some saints were removed and different ones added. The switch was an effort to make the calendar more "universal," and to allow for saints that came at a later time in history to be revered. Also, it is believed that since there was doubt as to *which* St. Valentine was celebrated on February 14, his name was subsequently removed. In truth, the general calendar is not something "fixed," and can change as the needs of the times permit. Could St. Valentine be added back to the Church calendar? Only time will tell...

Traditionally, Catholicism has four kinds of prayer:

- Adoration:** Praising God
- Contrition:** Asking for God's forgiveness
- Petition:** Asking God for a favor
- Thanksgiving:** Showing God gratitude

The Church believes that the Mass is the highest and supreme form of prayer, so it has all four elements in it. The Gloria is the adoration part of prayer, whereas the Confiteor and Penitential Rite are the contrition part. Later in the Mass, after the homily and the Nicene Creed, comes the Prayer of the Faithful, also known as the General Intercessions, or sometimes Universal Prayer, which is a prayer of petition. The thanksgiving part comes after Holy Communion, when gratitude is shown for all the graces given at Mass, especially in the Prayer after Communion offered for us all by the Priest.


