From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The Eucharist is the Real Presence of God, Jesus Christ, body and blood, under the appearance of bread and wine.

Eucharist is unique among the sacraments as it is at the heart of our faith. For Catholics, the Eucharist, or Mass, is the most powerful way we encounter the real presence of Jesus Christ. Sunday after Sunday (some, of course, gather every day), Catholics gather to celebrate the Eucharist, the ritual in which, by the power of the Holy Spirit, bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ. We who celebrate are also transformed, becoming Christ's presence to others, and recognizing the presence of Christ in others.

Symbols of Eucharist - Bread and Wine

Bread - Wheat is grown and ground, transformed by human work to make bread. Bread is a staple food of life.

Wine - Grapes are grown and crushed, transformed by human work to make wine. Wine symbolizes joy and celebration.

Bread and wine symbolize the Creator who gives life, the one who nourishes us. At the Last Supper, Jesus gave Himself in the form of bread and wine.

What happens during Eucharist?

The Eucharist (Eucharist is a Greek word that means "thanksgiving") is the whole ritual that has come to be known as the Mass. The Eucharist is therefore a holy moment which includes the consecration of the body and blood of Jesus. The Eucharist includes:

- the sharing of the Word from scripture
- offering of prayers
- doing what Jesus did at the Last Supper taking, blessing, breaking and sharing his body and blood
- being sent forth to live and proclaim the Good News

Blessed Carlo Acutis used to often say,

"The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven."

He participated in Holy Mass every day and would remain for long periods of time in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. Carlo would say, "Those who remain close to the Eucharist every day will go straight to Heaven."

After the Gloria, an opening prayer addresses all three persons of the Holy Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) and usually sets the tone for the rest of the prayers and Scripture readings at Mass. It begins by the priest saying, "Let us pray," and pauses for silence. Moments of silence provide space for a deeper experience of God's presence. The priest gathers or collects our prayers in the opening prayer which is called the Collect.

Every Sunday, holy day, and feast day (honoring a saint) has its own unique prayers and readings, depending on the time of year or priority of the feast.

During each element of the Liturgy of the Word that I've described so far, the priest, deacon, altar servers, and congregation stand throughout.

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.
