From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

We are now entering the most solemn time of the Liturgical Year.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday. On this day, we celebrate the triumphant entry of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, into Jerusalem, riding a donkey. On that day, the people laid palms before Him, a gesture reserved for triumphant leaders. We celebrate this at Mass by distributing palms to the faithful who may keep them for a time for use as devotional objects. The palms are blessed at Mass. The faithful sometimes craft portions of palm fronds into crosses.

On **Holy Thursday** evening at 7:00 p.m., we will celebrate the Lord's Supper. This evening Mass celebrates the wonderful Sacrament of the Eucharist; the great gift of Jesus to us. The Procession to the Repository will take place after Mass. The Stripping of the Altar reminds us of Christ's betrayal in the garden and His imprisonment after the Last Supper. Eucharistic Adoration will follow Mass until 10:00 p.m.

On **Good Friday** at 12 noon we will have Stations of the Cross and our service is at 3:00 p.m. This is not a Mass; rather, it is a Liturgy of the Word, Veneration of the Cross, and reception of Holy Communion Service. Adoration will begin at 8:00 a.m. on both Friday and Saturday morning.

Holy Saturday evening we celebrate the "Mother of All Vigils" namely the Easter Vigil. This will begin at 7:00 p.m. The first part of the Mass is a Service of Light with the singing of the Exsultet and the Gloria, followed by the Liturgy of the Word that incorporates several extra readings and responsorial psalms. This is followed with the Liturgy of the Eucharist. It is truly a beautiful and meaningful Liturgy. It is longer than a normal Sunday Mass. The Easter Vigil is the first and foremost Celebration of Easter.

Easter Sunday is the celebration of Christ's Victory over Death. It is the triumph of good over evil, life over death, Christ over Satan and sin. It is the Feast of the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

I invite you to participate in the Liturgy during Holy Week.

We are also offering additional times for Confession during Holy Week: Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday: 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

The Novena before Divine Mercy Sunday begins on Good Friday*.

I would also like to extend my gratitude to all those who joined me in making butter lambs for Easter. We had great fun!

After standing for the Gospel, the congregation sits and listens to the homily, which is different than a sermon. So often, the terms homily and sermon are used

interchangeably. Most people think they mean the same, but there is a slight difference.

Sermon: Any explanation and reflection on the Word of God.

Homily: A reflection that's preached at Mass after the Gospel and is read, and only read, by clergy - deacons, priests, or bishops. According to canon law, the local bishop may allow laity and religious brothers and sisters to preach a sermon under certain conditions, but they're never allowed to preach the homily itself.

During the homily, the priest, deacon or bishop connects the Scripture readings at Mass, to the daily lives of the people, the teaching of the Church, or the particular celebration at hand, such as a wedding or funeral.

We are nearing the conclusion of the first half of the Mass, called the Liturgy of the Word. Over the next few weeks we will conclude with the Reciting of the Nicene Creed and the Praying of the General Intercessions or sometimes called the Prayer of the Faithful.




Holy Week Begins with Holy Cross 8th Grade Students Presenting the Living Stations


