Today we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

This Feast celebrates the victory of Jesus over sin and death. Easter is so much more than a single celebration. Easter is so important that we cannot celebrate it in one day.

The Octave of Easter, eight days, *is* Easter Day. The Easter Season is a celebration of fifty days and each of these fifty days we celebrate Christ's Resurrection.

On Sundays and Solemnities the homily is followed by the Creed (Profession of Faith), which is ordinarily the ancient Nicene Creed of A.D. 325.

The Apostles Creed, an ancient symbol of Baptism, may be used during Lent and Easter time and occasionally at Masses for children. The entire congregation stands to recite or sometime sing the Creed. At the words, "by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man" all make a profound bow to show reverence for the Incarnation, from the Latin word "caro" for flesh.

The Incarnation refers to Jesus' taking on human flesh - being conceived in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On Solemnities of the Annunciation (March 25) and Christmas (December 25), all kneel instead of just bowing.

The Creed concisely sums up all that the Magisterium (the teaching authority of the Church) has taught for the past 2,000 years.



A TRADITIONAL POLISH EASTER BASKET

- Maslo (Butter)** - This dairy product is often shaped into a lamb (Baranek Wielkanocny) or a cross. This reminds us of the good will of Christ that we should have towards all things.
- Babka (Easter Bread)** - A round or long loaf topped with a cross or a fish, symbolic of Jesus, who is the Bread of Life.
- Chrzan (Horseradish)** - Symbolic of the Passion of Christ still in our minds.
- Jajka (Eggs) & Pisanki (decorated with symbols of Easter, of life, of prosperity)** - Indicates new life and Christ's Resurrection.
- Kielbasa (Sausage)** - A sausage product, symbolic of God's favor and generosity.
- Szynka (Ham)** - Symbolic of great joy and abundance. Some prefer lamb or veal. The lamb also reminds Christians that the Risen Christ is the "Lamb of God."
- Slonina (Smoked Bacon)** - A symbol of the overabundance of God's mercy and generosity.
- Sol (Salt)** - A necessary physical element. Symbolic of prosperity & justice and a reminder that people are the flavor of the earth.
- Ser (Cheese)** - Symbolic of the moderation Christians should have at all times.
- Candle** - Represents Christ as the Light of the World.
- Colorful Ribbons and Sprigs of Greenery** - are attached to the basket as signs of joy and new life in the season of spring and in celebration of the Resurrection.
- Linen Cover** - drawn over the top of the basket which is ready for the priest's visit to the home or the trip to church where it is joined with the baskets of others to await the blessing. The food is then set aside and enjoyed on Easter Sunday.
