The Ascension of the Lord

Thursday 5/18 at 8:00 am or 6:30 pm to Celebrate Mass.**



The ascension of Jesus describes Christ's transition from earth to heaven after his life, ministry, death, and resurrection. The Bible refers to the ascension as a passive action - Jesus was "taken up" into heaven.

Through the ascension of Jesus, God the Father exalted the Lord to his right hand in heaven. Even more important, at his ascension, Jesus promised his followers that he would soon pour out the Holy Spirit on them and in them.

Saint Devotions

May 15 - St. Isidore

St. Isidore, you know how normal it is to cultivate the land for you were employed as a farm laborer most of your life. Although you received God's help materially through Angels in the field, all farmers are aided spiritually to see the wonders God has strewn on this earth. Encourage all farmers in their labors and help them to feed many people.

May 18 - St. John I

Pope Saint John, you chose to value the truth of the Catholic faith over your own life. You remained steadfast in the proclamation of the Gospel until the end. Please pray for me, that I will never waver in my faith, and will never give in to temptations to water down that faith. May I have the same courage that you had so that God will be able to use me to reach out to those who need to know His saving truths.

Saint John I, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.

May 20 - St. Bernardine of Siena

St. Bernardine you were healed of respiratory illness and preached the love and mercy of God everywhere you went. I come to you now seeking prayers for [name of person] and all those who suffer with respiratory illnesses. Plead their cause in union with Mary, the Mother of God, and seek healing for them if it is God's will. Pray, dear Saint, that they suffer with joy, persevere with hope, and that they join their afflictions with Jesus' for the salvation of souls.

Deacon Thoughts with Dave

Upon the completion of the Presentation and Preparation of the Gifts (bread and wine), the Priest invites us to prayer by beginning: *Pray brethren that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.* We respond: *May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.*

Next, the Priest says a prayer over the gifts of bread and wine, addressed to almighty God, and always concluding with, *through Christ our Lord*, and we respond, *Amen.*

Mass continues with what is called the Preface Dialogue, between the Priest and the congregation. We hear the Priest begin. *The Lord be with you*, and we respond, *and with your spirit.* The priest continues, *lift up your hearts* and we respond, *we lift them up to the Lord.* The priest concludes, *let us give thanks to the Lord our God*, and we respond, *it is right and just.*

The Priest continues the Liturgy of the Eucharist by praying what is called the Preface. The Preface is an introductory prayer which leads us into the most holy and solemn part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, which is the Eucharistic Prayer.

The Preface concludes with our choir or cantor leading us in the Sanctus (Latin for Holy). This can also be recited by the congregation. *Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of Power and Might Heaven and Earth are full of Your Glory, Hosanna in the Highest. Blessed is He Who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosanna in the Highest.* These words are taken from Isaiah 6:3 and Revelation 4:8 as well as Mark 11:9-10.

Next week we will continue to move forward with the Eucharistic Prayer. Sincerely, Deacon Dave



On Tuesday, May 2nd, thanks to our Holy Cross Home & School Association, Simon's Heart brought their CPR Jukebox to our school for all 3rd through 8th graders. FOX29's very own Bob Kelly visited for his segment, Kelly's Classroom, to highlight this wonderful organization. Simon's Heart's mission is to create and advance innovative and evidence-based programs, policies, and research that prevent sudden cardiac arrest and death in children, teens, and young adults. Students learned the importance of the Chain of Survival steps they can take if someone is in need of help. The students also were able to practice how to use an AED machine. Holy Cross Regional Catholic School has a brand new AED machine in the school building close to the gymnasium and one in St. Eleanor Church. 
