# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

This past Thursday we celebrated the Feast of the Ascension of Jesus Christ, also called Ascension Day or Ascension Thursday. Ascension Day is traditionally celebrated the 40th day after Easter Sunday. This feast day commemorates Jesus Christ's ascension into heaven according to Christian belief.

Forty days after the resurrection, Jesus and his disciples went to Mount Olivet (Mount of Olives), near Jerusalem. There Jesus promised the disciples that they would soon receive the Holy Spirit, and asked them to remain in Jerusalem until the Spirit had come. As he blessed them he began to ascend into heaven to take his seat at the right hand of God. Luke, chapter 24, tells how Jesus leads the eleven disciples to Bethany, a village on the Mount of Olives, where he instructs them to remain in Jerusalem until the coming of the Holy Spirit:

*"And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven."*

This time between the Ascension and this coming Sunday, Pentecost, is a great opportunity, reflecting back to the experience the Apostles and Mary had, to prepare for The Holy Spirit promised by Jesus.

Yesterday, Saturday, May 20, 2023, in the Cathedral Basilica of SS. Peter and Paul, Archbishop Nelson Pérez presided over the ordination of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's newest priests. Let us keep them in our prayers as they begin serving their new parishes.

## ✠ Deacon Thoughts with Dave ✠

After the Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy), the congregation kneels for the first time.

The Eucharistic Prayer is part of the Mass which only the priest can say. However, I meditate in silence and ponder each word, and encourage you to do the same. The Eucharistic Prayer recalls what happened at the Last Supper. The sequence of events is retold until the part where Jesus takes the bread. Then the priest changes from third person to first person and speaks as if Christ himself were standing on-site holding the host. The priest acts in the person of Christ (in persona Christi) as another Christ (alter Christus). The priest doesn't say "This is Christ's body" or "This is Jesus' blood." He uses the same pronoun, My, because at the moment of consecration, the priest is Jesus.

The priest uses the same words that Jesus used at the Last Supper (Matthew 26:26-29) at the Consecration: "This is My body, which will be given up for you." He elevates the Host above the altar for everyone to see. The priest genuflects, takes the chalice of wine, and goes again from the third person to the first, speaking as Christ: "This is the cup of My blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It shall be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of Me."

He elevates the chalice, and he genuflects.


