# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The fundamental dogma, on which everything in Christianity is based, is that of the Blessed Trinity in whose name all Christians are baptized. The feast of the Blessed Trinity needs to be understood and celebrated as a prolongation of the mysteries of Christ and as the solemn expression of our faith in this triune life of the Divine Persons, to which we have been given access by Baptism and by the Redemption won for us by Christ. Only in heaven shall we properly understand what it means, in union with Christ, to share as sons in the very life of God.

The feast of the Blessed Trinity was introduced in the ninth century and was only inserted in the general calendar of the Church in the fourteenth century by Pope John XXII. But the cultus of the Trinity is, of course, to be found throughout the liturgy. Constantly, the Church causes us to praise and adore the thrice-holy God who has so shown His mercy toward us and has given us to share in His life.

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity may well be regarded as the Church's Te Deum of gratitude over all the blessings of the Christmas and Easter seasons; for this mystery is a synthesis of Christmas, Epiphany, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost. This feast, which falls on the first Sunday after Pentecost, should make us mindful that actually every Sunday is devoted to the honor of the Most Holy Trinity, that every Sunday is sanctified and consecrated to the Triune God. Sunday after Sunday we should recall in a spirit of gratitude the gifts which the Blessed Trinity is bestowing upon us. The Father created and predestined us; on the first day of the week He began the work of creation. The Son redeemed us; Sunday is the "Day of the Lord," the day of His resurrection. The Holy Spirit sanctified us, made us His temple; on Sunday the Holy Spirit descended upon the infant Church. Sunday, therefore, is the day of the Most Holy Trinity.

On the Sunday after Trinity Sunday, the Church celebrates The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Processions often take place in churches around the world. The 'Body of Christ' is carried out of the church and into the public for people to see in a monstrance. The Feast commemorates the immense gift of the Eucharist in our lives and it affirms the belief that we have in the transubstantiation.

Transubstantiation is the belief that the bread and wine is transformed into the body and blood of Christ during the Eucharist. The festival also celebrates the belief that Jesus sacrificed his life to save the world.

Next Sunday, we will have a Eucharistic Procession after the 10:00 am Mass. Please come to praise the Lord present in the Holy Eucharist.

*I adore You at every moment, You are our living Bread in this Sacrament.*

### June 6 - *St. Norbert*

Father, you made the bishop Norbert an outstanding minister of your Church, renowned for his preaching and pastoral zeal. ### June 9 - *St. Ephrem*

### June 11 - *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*

Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me. Water from the side of Christ, wash me. Passion of Christ, strengthen me.

## Deacon Thoughts with Dave

We continue our reflection on the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass. Catholicism professes that during the Consecration, a miracle occurs - the priest consecrates the bread and wine: Just as Jesus did at the Last Supper, the priest takes the bread in the form of a Host and says, "This is my body." Then he elevates the Host for the congregation to see, the gong is struck six times in our parish, to alert everyone of what has taken place, and then the priest genuflects. Then the priest takes the chalice (cup) of wine, saying, "This is the cup of My Blood," elevates the chalice, once again the gong is struck six times, and the priest genuflects.

Now it's the body and blood of Christ; it still looks, feels, tastes like bread and wine, but it's not. This change of bread and wine into the true presence of Jesus' Body and Blood is called "transubstantiation."

The Bible says that God created merely by speaking. "God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light." (Genesis 1:3) Likewise, by invoking the Holy Spirit, by speaking the words of Christ at the last supper over the bread and wine during Holy Communion, the priest changes them into the body and blood, soul and divinity of Christ through the authority given to him by the Sacrament of Holy Orders. Only an ordained priest has the authority to say Mass and consecrate the bread and wine.


