# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The Queenship of Mary is celebrated on August 22. "Queen of Heaven", or *Regina Caeli* in Latin, is a title given to the Virgin Mary, by Christians mainly of the Catholic Church.

The Memorial of the Queenship of Mary was first instituted in 1954 by Pope Pius XII. According to Catholic tradition, as Christ is king of the world and saves the people from their sins, Mary is queen over the earth because of her role in the story of divine redemption, serving as mother to the Savior.

With the certainty of faith we know that Jesus Christ is king in the full, literal, and absolute sense of the word; for He is true God and man. This does not, however, prevent Mary from sharing His royal prerogatives, though in a limited and analogous manner; for she was the Mother of Christ, and Christ is God; and she shared in the work of the divine Redeemer, in His struggles against enemies and in the triumph He won over them all.

From this union with Christ the King she assuredly obtains so eminent a status that she stands high above all created things; and upon this same union with Christ is based that royal privilege enabling her to distribute the treasures of the kingdom of the divine Redeemer. And lastly, this same union with Christ is the fountain of the inexhaustible efficacy of her motherly intercession in the presence of the Son and of the Father.

Spurred on by piety and faith, may we glory in being subject to the rule of the Virgin Mother of God; she bears the royal scepter in her hand, while her heart is ever aflame with mother love.

We should be grateful that Mary, Mother of Jesus, is our Mother too and Queen of Heaven!



Step deeper into your faith daily: read a section of the Catechism, pray over a verse of Scripture, listen to a Catholic podcast while driving or walking, pray. **Adopt-a-missionary:** St. Thérèse was a "spiritual sister" to several missionaries, writing them letters and supporting them in prayer, indirectly helping hundreds of souls. Adopt a missionary - or anyone who shares the Faith. **Intercession fueled by charity:** St. Thérèse lovingly offered to God the "thorns" she received from others - discomforts, misunderstandings, hurt feelings - to win souls for Christ. 
