

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

October is traditionally dedicated to the prayer of the Rosary. Where does this custom come from and what are the beginnings of praying the Rosary?

The custom of repeating a certain number of prayers counted down for convenience with the help of a string with beads or knots has been, and is, found in many religions.

The first hermits assigned themselves to recite certain amounts of prayer every day. They made it easier for themselves by using strings with knots or strings with loops or pieces of wood. Such a rosary is said to have been held by St. Pachomius and St. Benedict of Norcia. The oldest of the preserved rosaries comes from the twelfth century. The rope consisted of 158 beads.

The prayer of the Rosary that we pray today consists of the Creed, the Our Father, the Hail Mary, and the Glory to the Father. The most beautiful and oldest prayer of Christians is the Lord's Prayer, which Jesus himself taught. The first monastic rules obliged monks to repeat it many times during the day. The prayers arranged in this way were called the Psalter of the Brethren.

From the first centuries too, Christianity has recognized the great value of praying to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Since the twelfth century, the custom of reciting the Angelic Greeting has spread in the Catholic Church. The prayer initially consisted only of the words "Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord with you, blessed are you among women". Over time, the words of St. Elizabeth and other words began to be added. The epidemics of the Black Death, raging in the Middle Ages, caused the greeting to be accompanied by a request to Mary to pray: "for us sinners now and at the hour of our death". It often happened that the Hail Mary was recited 100 times, among others, in memory of the work of creation. The present form of the "Angelic Greeting" was finally formed in the fifteenth century. With time, the Hail Mary began to be added to the prayer of the Our Father. These two most popular prayers in the Church gave rise to the prayer of the Rosary.

So, now that it is October, I invite you to open yourself to the beautiful experience and joy of God's presence in the history of man's salvation, through the prayerful reverie of the rosary.

Join us in our beautiful Church every Wednesday in October at 6:30 pm to pray the Rosary together as a parish family.




