# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Where did the name rosary come from?

One explanation is that the name "rosary" derives from St. Dominic, widely regarded as the father of the rosary. Legend has it that Our Lady appeared to Dominic and instructed him to recite the Psalter of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Dominic listened to Mary, preached the word and interspersed it with meditation combined with the recitation of the Rosary.

In the time of St. Dominic it was a common custom to see the connection between the spiritual and material worlds. Creation was thought to be a book about God. In nature, signs of spiritual realities were seen. Flowers were privileged in this respect. Loved ones were given names of flowers, and also often determined the characteristics of people by comparison to flowers, e.g. purity was symbolized by a lily or a rose. Pious practices were also treated as spiritual flowers. The recitation of the Psalter of the Blessed Virgin Mary was compared to the offering of 150 roses to the Mother of God, which is why this prayer was called the "wreath of roses", or rosary. Dominic Alamus a la Roche established the number of 150 Hail Mary prayers on the model of the Book of Psalms, which he divided into dozens, each interspersed with the prayer of the Our Father. With time, the recitation of prayer began to be combined with meditation on the mysteries of the life of Christ and Mary. In the sixteenth century, 15 mysteries were finally established, divided into 3 parts (joyful, sorrowful and glorious). This was the case until 2002, when John Paul II added Part IV of the Holy Rosary – mysteries of light.

Today, the prayer of the Rosary is one of the most popular prayers of the Church. Every Catholic knows it. It is, in fact, a simple prayer. It can be recited at any time and in any place.

Pope Pius V instituted the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7, 1571. Leo XIII recommended the recitation of the Rosary throughout the month of October and introduced into the Litany of Loreto the invocation "Queen of the Holy Rosary, pray for us."

The apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary also contributed to the spread of this prayer. This was the case, for example, in Lourdes, Fatima, Mexico or Gietrzwałd, Poland and many other places.

Join us in our beautiful Church every Wednesday in October at 6:30 pm to pray the Rosary together as a parish family.




**Garden Club:** Students began work for the Garden club. They saw how much their garden grew over the summer. We even have some pumpkins growing, just in time for Halloween!




