# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The Rosary is one of the traditional ways of Christian prayer used to contemplate the face of Christ. In praying the Rosary, we see the whole life of the Son of God and, together with Mary, we walk in His ways. That is why the Rosary is the favorite prayer of the saints. Let us recite this prayer often and be aware of its great effectiveness.

To recite the rosary correctly means to pray and meditate at the same time. This makes the recitation of the Rosary such a wonderful spiritual experience. Each of the mysteries of the Rosary focuses on one important event in the life of Jesus Christ and his mother, Mary. The mysteries are broken out into four different parts of Jesus' life. Each part contains five mysteries. When you look at your Rosary, you will notice there are 5 decades of beads - one for each mystery of each grouping!

The mysteries should be recited as follows:

- Joyful Mysteries - Monday and Saturday
- Sorrowful Mysteries - Tuesday and Friday
- Glorious Mysteries - Wednesday and Sunday
- Luminous Mysteries - Thursday

The **Joyful Mysteries** are taken mostly from Saint Luke's Gospel in the New Testament. They involve the joyful events of Jesus' childhood.

The **Sorrowful Mysteries** remind us of how much Jesus loves us. They recall how He suffered and died just for us.


The **Glorious Mysteries** tell us what happened after Jesus died - His Resurrection, the descent of the Holy Spirit and the love Jesus had for his Mother.

The **Luminous Mysteries** bring a deeper understanding to the public life of Jesus. They fill in the blanks between the childhood of Jesus and His suffering and death on the cross.

Our website has a guide to the prayers and mysteries. Feel free to utilize it. Read about each mystery and then meditate on it while you pray the Rosary.






