# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Following Christmas, we emerged into a new liturgical season that began on January 9<sup>th</sup>; the first phase of Ordinary Time. This phase of Ordinary Time is between Christmas, including the Baptism of the Lord, and Lent. It will end on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, February 13th, when we enter the season of Lent.

Every liturgical season is represented by a different color. The color for Ordinary Time in the liturgy is Green. You will see this reflected in the garments the priests wear on the altar as well as the linens used.

Except for feast days, we dedicate each day of the week in Ordinary Time to a different daily intention.

**Daily Intentions/Dedications:**

- Monday: The Holy Trinity
- Tuesday: Angels and Saints
- Wednesday: St. Joseph - Patron of Death and the Universal Church
- Thursday: The Last Supper and the Institution of the Holy Eucharist and Priesthood
- Friday: The Passion of our Lord and Most Sacred Heart of Jesus
- Saturday: The Blessed Mary
- Sunday: The Day of the Resurrection of our Lord and Divine Providence

I encourage each of you, dear parishioners, to live Ordinary Time in an **extraordinary** way by honoring and following these dedications each day.


## Saint Of The Day

### Jan 23 - St. Vincent

Vincent was born in today's Spain and carries the title of "protomartyr," indicating he was the first man to die for Christ on the Iberian Peninsula. As with many early saints, many legends are attributed to him. Refusing to renounce his faith, he was jailed with his Bishop, who gave him permission to preach. Being filled with the Holy Spirit, the deacon gave his "sermon" with serenity in the face of torture and death. His torture continued, yet Vincent remained at peace, for he did not fear "those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul" (Matthew 10:28). The legend concludes that Vincent's joy in the face of this torture was so great that it caused one of his jailers to immediately convert.

### Jan 24 - St. Francis de Sales

St. Francis de Sales is admired throughout the Church for his great sanctity, learning, missionary zeal, gentleness, and understanding of the human heart. He is best described as a Christian Humanist, a potent spiritual force for creating a spirituality admirably suited to those in every walk of life. He was active in the struggle against Calvinism and cofounded the order of Visitation Nuns. He wrote the devotional classic *Introduction to a Devout Life*, which emphasized that spiritual perfection is possible for people active in the world and not only for those who withdraw from society.



### Jan 25 - Conversion of St. Paul

In the long history of the Church no conversion has been more consequential than St. Paul's. Paul had not only been ambivalent toward the Church before he converted; he had actively persecuted it. But he changed, or God changed him, on one particular night. And on that night Christianity changed too. And when the course of Christianity changed, the world changed.

### Jan 26 - Sts. Timothy and Titus

Timothy and Titus were close companions of the Apostle Paul and bishops of the Catholic Church in its earliest days. Both men received letters from St. Paul, which are included in the New Testament. Ancient sources state that St. Timothy followed his mentor in dying as a martyr for the faith. In the year 93, during his leadership of the Church in Ephesus, he took a stand against the worship of idols and was consequently killed by a mob. Titus is credited with leading the Church of Crete well into his 90s, overturning paganism and promoting the faith through his prayers and preaching. Unlike St. Timothy, St. Titus was not martyred, but died peacefully in old age.

### Jan 27 - St. Angela Merici

St. Angela Merici was an Italian religious educator and founder of the Ursulines whose deep prayer life and relationship with the Lord bore the fruit of mystical encounters with God. At just 10-years-old, Angela and her older sister became orphans and went to live with their uncle. There they led a quiet and devout Catholic Christian life. She founded the Company of St. Ursula in 1535 in Brescia, in which women dedicated their lives to the service of the Church through the education of girls. From this organization later sprang the monastic Order of Ursulines, whose nuns established places of prayer and learning throughout Europe and, later, worldwide, most notably in North America.

## Deacon Thoughts with Dave

### We are Baptized into the Body of Christ.

For Christians, community has always been an important and essential part of life. Christ is at the center, and the community is built around Him. Baptism is the way we enter that community and become members of the body of Christ, the Church. Once baptized, we share in the privileges and the life of this community of believers.

Many people think of baptism as a private family affair, but being baptized connects us in a deep and eternal way with a much larger family: the family of God.

Baptism is the sign of salvation given to us by Christ to bring us into the kingdom of God (see John 3:5). A person enters "into Christ" (Romans 6:3, Galatians 3:7) at the time of baptism, and the gift of the Spirit is given at that time. "We are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with him, so that we may be glorified with him." (Romans 8:16-18).

As adopted sons and daughters of God, Christians share in Jesus' own relationship with his Father - a relationship so intimate that they, like Jesus, can freely and with every confidence address the Lord of heaven as "Father."

Reflect this week. As a child of God, what riches will you inherit through baptism? Secondly, what responsibilities come with those riches?
