From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As the Season of Lent approaches, we call to mind the three pillars that lead us through this time; prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. As you begin to craft your plan of how to make the most of Lent, let me present to you something new to help foster the pillar of prayer and act as food for our journey.

If you are concerned about the dwindling number of young people who are heeding God's call; if you worry that we won't have enough priests in the future for Liturgy and Eucharist; then please consider, in your heart, to host the Pilgrim Chalice for a week in your home.

The Pilgrim Chalice consists of a real chalice that previously held wine, along with a paten, that held hosts; and, after the Consecration, the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

The chalice can be signed out to reside with you for one week. During that week, we ask that you pray for an increase in vocations and consecrated life. Starting the first week of Lent, parishioners will have the opportunity to intensify their prayers for vocations with a visit with the Pilgrim Chalice.

We pray that God will continue to choose those whom He will, to send forth as workers in His vineyard.

Feb 17 - *The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order*

The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order were seven holy men of the town of Florence whom became bound to each other in a spiritual friendship. They found themselves in a society in which many people ignored God's law. Riches and the easy life meant more to these people than the love of the poor and service to the needy. These seven men decided to withdraw from the city and to lead lives of prayer and penance. They chose to turn their lives over to God and give witness to all that is good and true. It took great courage for these men to leave their prosperous businesses and live a life of prayer and penance. They had been leaders in society, so their decision to change their way of living caused a stir and inspired others to rethink their values and make some changes in their lives. This group of men fostered devotion to the Blessed Virgin, particularly in her seven sorrows. They called themselves the Servants of Mary or Servites

We know the importance of water for life. We know, too, that a person can live weeks without food but only a few days without water to drink. Water is the main element that makes up living tissue - as much as 99 percent. No wonder our Lord chose water to represent the beginning of the new Christian life in Baptism.

But water can remind us of death as well (flooding, drowning). This is another reason why our Lord chose water to represent the end of the old life and the beginning of the new Christian life.

The waters of Baptism remind us that Christ has washed us clean of sin and reconciled us with God. In Baptism, all of our sins - even original sin, the fallen state of human beings - are washed away. That's why the Baptismal promises, include renunciation of sin and a profession of personal faith.

We will continue next week reflecting on the Sacrament of Baptism.

Why do Catholics have to fast on Ash Wednesday?

Fasting is a practice with Biblical roots, most notably, when Jesus fasted for 40 days in the desert. Those in good health, aged 18-59, are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. We're permitted one full meal and two smaller meals that together don't equal the full meal. This includes abstaining from meat. Fasting expresses our recognition that we've sinned and desire to make amends. It purifies our hearts and frees them to love God and others well.


