## Saint Of The Day

### March 4 - *St. Casimir*

Casimir grew up in a world where his life was not his own. As a prince of Poland, the second son of King Casimir IV and Elizabeth of Austria, his life was scheduled to cement his father's authority and increase Poland's power. Casimir realized from an early age that his life belonged to someone else, but to a much higher King than his father. Despite pressure, humiliation, and rejection, he stood by that loyalty through his whole life. Casimir is patron saint of Poland and Lithuania. Courageous and strong in character, his integrity, fairness, and love for those in need deeply impressed the ruling class of Poland; his people called him "the Peacemaker."

### March 7 - *Sts. Perpetua and Felicity*


Sts. Perpetua and Felicity were Christian martyrs who lived during the early persecution of the Church in Africa by the Emperor Severus. The actual record of the courage of Perpetua and Felicity was written by Perpetua and is known as "The Passion of St. Perpetua, St. Felicitas, and their Companions." Despite threats of persecution and death, Perpetua, Felicity - a slave woman and expectant mother - and three companions refused to renounce their Christian faith. For their unwillingness, all were sent to the public games in the amphitheater. Perpetua's record of her trial and imprisonment ends the day before the games. "Of what was done in the games themselves, let him write who will." The diary was finished by a witness.

### March 8 - *St. John of God*

John, a former soldier, devoted the rest of his life to God's service. He was visited by Saint John, who advised him to be actively involved in tending to the needs of others rather than in enduring personal hardships. John gained peace of heart, and began work among the poor. Behind John's outward acts of total concern and love for Christ's sick and poor was a deep interior prayer life which was reflected in his spirit of humility.

## ✠ Deacon Thoughts with Dave

Let us begin to explore and reflect on the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Many of us lack confidence when it comes to speaking to others about our faith in Jesus Christ.

Jesus promised the apostles he would give them the courage needed to speak of him to others: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8).

Jesus kept his promise. When they received the Holy Spirit, the apostles immediately went out to preach the good news. If they had any reluctance or fear, it was forgotten.

"When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong, driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted, and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." (Acts 2:1-4)

Christ fulfills his promise to us as well through the Sacrament of Confirmation. In Confirmation we receive courage and other gifts of the Holy Spirit that we need in order to be witnesses to Christ in our daily lives.

We will continue our reflection on the Sacrament of Confirmation over the next several weeks of Lent.

The services of ordination of a bishop include:

- Presentation of the ordinand to the ordaining bishop or bishops
- The ordinand's Declaration of Consent that states his or her belief in the scriptures and conformity to the doctrine, discipline, and worship of the Episcopal Church
- The people's consent to the ordination and their promise to uphold the ordinand in the new ministry
- The Litany for Ordinations:
  - Lessons and sermon
  - The examination of the candidate
  - The singing of the hymn "Veni Creator Spiritus" or "Veni Sancte Spiritus"

The "Come, Holy Spirit" prayer is chanted after the Gospel reading, and marks the beginning of the Ordination Rite of the Mass. The ancient prayer invokes the Holy Spirit.
