

## From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

The end of May and the beginning of June are normally a time of graduation for students. Graduation is a time of joy and jubilation when we celebrate accomplishment and achievement. It is the celebration of a task successfully finished. This weekend we celebrate a different kind of accomplishment; the accomplishment of redemption. Jesus completed his ministry entrusted on him by His Father and returned to him gloriously. This celebration is called the Ascension of Jesus.

The Ascension is not only the completion of Jesus' mission, but the beginning of the mission of the Church, also. Thus the Ascension is not only about Jesus but also about each one of us. Before the Ascension, Jesus said to his disciples: You will receive the power from the Holy Spirit and you will be my witness in Jerusalem and to the ends of the earth (Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11).

Our mission is a mission of witnessing/evangelizing. "Lighthouses blow no horns; they only shine." The basic condition for witnessing is a personal encounter with the risen Lord. According to Pope Francis every baptized person is a "cristoforo," a bearer of Christ. Whoever has encountered Christ, as the Samaritan woman at the well, cannot keep this experience to him/herself, but has the desire to share it, to bring Jesus to others (cf. John 4). It is for all of us to ask ourselves if one who meets us perceives in our life the warmth of faith, sees in our face the joy of having encountered Christ!

The starting point of this missionary mandate is our family itself. I was at someone's home for dinner. This little girl said the prayer before the meal. "Do you believe in God?" I asked her. "Yes Father, I do," she replied. "How do you know there is a God?" "My mom told me," she answered. "How does your Mom know about it?" I asked her again. "Her Mom told her," this little girl replied. Home is the school where we learn the basics of life. Parents are the television children watch all the time.

This pandemic is really upsetting us. However, there is something good about this pandemic. It is the gift of time. We have more family time. When we are physically away from the parish church, it is highly advisable to focus on our domestic church. Maybe you can prepare a family altar and watch our YouTube and livestream Masses in front of your family altar.

May God continue to bless all of you at this difficult time. Let us pray for each other especially those who are going through struggles. I appreciate your spiritual communion with Christ and the community, and am extremely grateful for your generous financial contributions to the church in spite of this difficult time.




