

# From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

### Dear Friends,

There was a brain storming session in Hell, the topic of discussion was how to bring more people to Hell. The Chief Devil invited suggestions. The first said, "I will tell them there is no God." Satan said, "That will not delude many, for they know that there is a God." The second said, "I will tell them there is no Hell." Satan answered, "You will receive no one that way; men know even now that there is a Hell for sin." The third said, "I will tell them there is no hurry there is time." "Go," said Satan.

The most dangerous action any one can do is procrastination. The procrastinator makes the unwise assumption that tomorrow will surely arrive. No person can make such an assumption. "Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth" (Prov. 27:1). Procrastination is not only a wrong use of time in the present, but also an unwise assumption about the future.

The best example for this truth is the parable of the 10 virgins. The foolish did not realize the four basic principles of life. They are: 1. Time and tide will wait for none. 2. There are certain things which cannot be obtained at the last minute. 3. There are certain things which cannot be borrowed. 4. Today will never come back.

People say, "I am really busy today. Let us do it tomorrow." St. Augustine realized his folly long before his conversion. However, he postponed his decision to return to God. He said, "I will go to Him but not today." This can happen to any of us.

All are busy. Because of our 'busy-ness' we did not enjoy yesterday, we are not enjoying today and we will not enjoy tomorrow. Thomas Gray said, "Yesterday is a history, tomorrow is a mystery, today is the reality, so act in the living present..." It is true. 'Now' is the only thing that I can say with all certainty that I have it. Every day is a blessing. Every day brings blessings. Everyday gives us an opportunity for a fresh beginning.

If you have an inspiration to do something honorable today, do not miss it. Every inspiration is an opportunity of grace. Imagine the missed fortune of the people who denied the invitation of Jesus with excuses! Similarly, the 'Innkeepers' did not realize that they were saying no to 'the savior of the world'. Be alert. Be vigilant. Be ready. God is the God of the present.

A young man eagerly described what he dreamed of doing for the poor. Said the Master, 'When do you propose to make your dream come true?' 'As soon as the opportunity arrives.' 'Opportunity never arrives,' said the Master. It is here.

# ST. FRANCIS XAVIER PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION & SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMS

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: For children in the 1st-5th grades attending public or non-Catholic private school. This program presents religious education and sacramental preparation information in a fun and innovative way. Baptized children generally begin their Sacramental Preparation in the first grade, and complete their sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the 2nd grade. (Note: If your child is older than 3rd grade, baptized but has not yet made their First Holy Communion, we do have a Sacramental Preparation class for them). Classes will begin in October online, then transition to in-person instruction as soon as possible.



**CONFIRMATION (for teens):** Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this sacrament designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school years, although most start as freshmen. Classes will begin in October online, then

transition to in-person instruction as soon as possible.

**ADULT CONFIRMATION:** If you have already received the sacraments of Baptism and First Holy Communion, but have not yet been Confirmed, we do have an adult Confirmation program beginning early 2021. RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN: If you are interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation, we have an excellent program for you called "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults" (RCIA). The St. Francis Xavier parish community invites you meet with members of the RCIA team who welcome your interest and questions regarding the Catholic Church and our parish community.




