

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Parishioners,

Finally, the day has arrived. After 15 months of covid-19 restricted life, we are returning to the normalcy of life. Let us be grateful to God for his enduring mercy and care. I am sincerely appreciative of everyone, especially the volunteers of our parish, who genuinely helped to sail through this unprecedented experience. I am also grateful to all our parishioners for their patience with hope. My heart goes with sympathy for those who lost their loved ones due to the pandemic and also my prayers that God may restore those who have been affected one way or the other during this difficult time.

The Archbishop through his letter invites the Faithful of the Archdiocese to return to in-person Sunday Mass and celebrations of the Sacraments. He also informs the faithful that effective June 19, the dispensation from the obligation to attend the Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation will be lifted for the Catholic Faithful of the Archdiocese. Those who have serious and legitimate reasons are, however, dispensed from the obligations to attend the Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation.

With this in mind, I am happy to announce that we, the St. Francis Xavier Church, is beginning to have all liturgical celebrations and other religious services indoors without capacity limitations and social distancing, starting Saturday June 19. Live stream will continue to be posted on our Facebook for those who are sick or have underlining health conditions.

All weekend Masses except Sunday 8:00 am Mass will be indoors. A special area in the church will be reserved for people who prefer social distancing. Holy Communion will be distributed at the regular time. For now, Holy Communion will be offered in the form of bread and on the hand is strongly encouraged.

All liturgical ministries can begin their services starting this weekend. For now, masks and social distancing are required for employees and volunteers if they are working in the Church during Mass. For example, ushers and greeters while they are exercising their ministry and EM's while distributing communion.

Masks are not required for fully vaccinated individuals attending Mass, but masks are required for unvaccinated individuals outdoors when social distancing is not possible and at all times indoors. Even though wearing a mask is not mandatory, if you feel more comfortable wearing a mask you are encouraged to use it as a precaution. The hand sanitizers are available in multiple locations in the church for those who wish to use it.

As I mentioned above, we were able to face the challenges and emerge stronger than before because of your steadfastness in faith. In spite of the challenges you very generously supported the changes in our Church. Thank you to all those that made donations to our multiple canopies, to Rita and Brad Recker for their time to plan, arrange and rearrange the canopies, and other things needed for our liturgical celebrations. Jack Clapper had the most difficult job; moving in and out the musical instruments and mic sets for indoor and outdoor Masses. He did it graciously. A group of volunteers came every Sunday morning (even on weekdays) around 7 a,m to prepare the parking lot, clean the chairs, arrange the flowers and the altar. Their incredible service tells us how much they love SFX Church. Another group of volunteers that deserve special mention is our Greeter/Ushers. They welcomed you while keeping you safe. Our filming volunteers dedicated their talents while sharing the Mass with those at home. And our many volunteers that disinfected our worship space each week. Thank you.

As Paul says, "We walk by faith" (2 Corinthians 5:7). God is walking with us all the time; sometimes more visibly than other times. During the pandemic, He leads us differently. The pandemic has helped us to grow strong in our faith, strengthen our mutual bond and practice our faith through more creative ways. Let us use the wealth of our experience to go forward with more vigor and passion. Let this post pandemic era be a time of renewal and commitment. Please start coming to Church and be nourished by the Holy Eucharist.






