From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Each year, the Catholic Church in the United States commemorates the third Sunday in September as "Catechetical Sunday." On this Sunday, we recognize our catechists, teachers and volunteers who make our program of religious education possible and pray for the Church's mission that is to teach the Gospel to all people. Theme for this year's Catechetical Sunday is "Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed."

This theme is so timely as the whole world is wounded in some way and in need of healing that can only come from Jesus. The role of Catechists is to echo the Good News that Jesus is with us to heal our brokenness. In fact, the root word catechesis is from a Greek word meaning to 'echo or resound.'

Every baptized Christian is a catechist. Everyone has the noble obligation of sharing faith. St. Paul wrote, "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures." Our life must echo our belief.

In the process of catechizing, parents' role come first. Parents are the primary catechists in their children's lives, and the catechists assist parents in their sacred task of handing on the faith. Parents' teaching role is distinct from that of a catechist. Parents teach by example of lived faith; catechists teach by instruction. Theirs is a pedagogical role. Catechists educate; that is, they lead their students to know the content of what the Church knows and believes about God.

According to our Catholic belief, we grow in faith through the Sacramental life of the Church. Sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us. The Council of Trent teaches that, it is through the sacraments that all true sanctity either begins, or being begun, is increased, or being lost is restored. Therefore, all the sacraments are equally important. They confer graces at various stages of a person's life where the presence of grace is critically significant. Baptism cleanses us, Confirmation strengthens us, Confession sanctifies us, Holy Eucharist nourishes us, Holy Matrimony/ Holy Orders commissions us and Anointing of the sick heals us.

On this Catechetical Sunday, let us ask these questions. 1. Do I have the Sacrament of initiation? The three sacraments, Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, together constitute the Sacrament of Initiation. Through these three Sacraments a person becomes a full-fledged member of the Church. 2. Is my marriage sacramental? (If you would like to get your marriage blessed, please call to the office.) 3. Do I receive the Holy Eucharist regularly? 4. How often do I celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation? 5.Am I missing any Sacraments?

Our parish has great catechetical programs with great catechists. On this catechetical Sunday, I express my sincere gratitude to Rosie Roope, Dn. Jim, Dr. Sullivan, Jonatan Zamora, Paula Lucero and the catechists who volunteer their time to our parish community. The information and the formation you provide as a catechist influences many lives and through those lives' society and culture.

Let the example of our catechists inspire us to service, especially those who have not yet found a parish ministry. When everyone gets involved in parish life, God's love echoes more powerfully and clearly to a world in desperate need of healing. Let us be an ambassador of Christ.

Prayer for the Catechists:

Loving Father, we pray today for our catechists. We thank you for their gift of ministry in your church. Grant them your wisdom that they may grow in the understanding and teaching of your Word. Grant them also your love that they may be fruitful heralds of your Word and lead others to love you.

Pour forth your Holy Spirit upon them to grant them wisdom about what is important; knowledge of the truths of faith; understanding of their meaning; right judgement about how to apply them in life; courage to persevere even in the face of adversity; reverence before all that is sacred and holy; and that loving zeal which leads others to a transforming encounter with your Son. We pray this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: For children in the 1st-5th grades attending public or non-Catholic school, this program presents religious education and sacramental preparation information in a fun and innovative way. Baptized children generally begin their Sacramental Preparation in the first grade, and complete their sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the 2nd



grade. (Note: If your child is older than 3rd grade, baptized but has not yet made their First Holy Communion, we do have a Sacramental Preparation class for them). Classes will begin in late September. Meet Wednesdays after school 4-5 p.m.



CONFIRMATION (for teens): Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this sacrament designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school

years, although most start as freshmen.

ADULT CONFIRMATION: If you have already received the sacraments of Baptism and First Holy Communion, but have not yet been Confirmed, we do have an adult Confirmation program. For more information, please contact Rosie Roope at <u>rosie.roope@gmail.com</u>.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN: If you are interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation, we have an excellent program for you called "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults" (RCIA). 
