From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. We, Christians, believe in one God. We also believe that this one God has three persons- God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. This is, however, a difficult notion to understand. As we do today, people in the past had difficulties understanding the mystery of the Trinity. People always ask: "How is it possible to have three persons in one God or how does one God become three persons?" Our traditional answer is that it is a mystery. Of course, it is a mystery but a reality as well.

The notion of Trinity was developed based on human experience and divine revelation. In the past people experienced God as a Creator, someone who is beyond human reach. In the New Testament period, people had a different experience of the one and the same God, namely, God as Emmanuel, as someone with them. Today we experience God as Spirit, someone who is within us. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are different forms or expressions of the one God. They are different levels of God's Existence, and they are different expressions of God's Love. At least one place in the Bible the whole trinity made an appearance. This was at the time of Jesus' Baptism.

What is important for us is not the ontological discussion of the nature of the Trinity, but the message of the Trinity. It is very simple: God is a relationship. God is a communion of three persons. If God is a relationship, then relationship is the medium through which God operates. Jesus himself made it amply clear when he said' "When two or three are gathered together in my name I will be in their midst." The importance of community is evident from the working style of Jesus. The very first act Jesus did after his baptism was to form a group of disciples. The last thing Jesus did before the crucifixion was the institution of the Eucharist, the perfect symbol of fellowship. The first thing Jesus did after his resurrection was to gather the scattered disciples. Similarly, when Jesus sent them on a mission, he sent them in twos. Community and communion is basic to Christin spirituality.

Consequently, to have a God experience, we need three things. First, we must be in communion with one another. Remember Jesus' words:" Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and remember that your brother or sister have something against you, leave your gift there before the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift...." (Mt 5:23). Secondly, we must help building up Jesus' community. We, the SFX Community are a great example of working together. Our Faire is the proof. I am so grateful to everyone who spent day and night with one heart and mind to make our Faire a great success. Thank you. Also SFX community is extremely grateful to all our Sponsors and Donors. I appreciate every person who gave of their time, resources, donations and energy to this event. May God bless their generosity.

And finally we celebrate our fraternity in the Eucharistic celebration. We are the Body of Christ, and we nourish our body by receiving the Body of Christ/Holy Communion. In the Eucharistic celebration we exercise our identity.

St. Francis Xavier School is currently accepting names to be placed on our waiting list of students interested in entering Transitional Kindergarten through Eighth Grade in August 2022. All families who wish to have their children considered for Fall entrance are asked to contact the school office between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through

Friday. This includes families who have children currently enrolled at St. Francis Xavier School and would like younger or older siblings considered for admission.

In regard to Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten Applicants: Due to the difference between ability and maturity levels and the corresponding relationship to school readiness, Kindergarten applicants must turn 5 years old by November 1st to be eligible to take the entrance screening. Transitional Kindergarten applicants must turn 4 years old by November 1st to be eligible for the entrance screening. We look forward to meeting with you!
