From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. This is primarily since the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7th. The feast was introduced by Pope St Pius V (1504-1572) in the year 1571 to commemorate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571.

In talking about missionary discipleship, Pope Francis once challenged his congregation. He pulled a Rosary from his pocket and asked the crowd if they also carried a Rosary with them! The Pope prayed the entire Rosary every day. "May the Rosary never fall from your hands." Saint Pope John XXIII.

Think about the year when Mary appeared to the three young children. World War I was raging in Europe. Mary appeared to children, to the child-like, those simple and pure of heart, and through them helped the whole Church to draw close to the mystery of Christ and thus to read the signs of the time in the light of Christ. Today more than ever before, as the world is going crazy with secularism, we need Mary's help. "Anyone who fled to Mary's intercession, was never left unaided."

Mary lead us to Jesus....If she did it at Cana, she will do it again at our homes. In this month of October, let us consider this beautiful prayer of the Rosary as a means that we too can use to draw closer to Jesus and Mary by meditating on the great mysteries of our salvation. To honor Mary, we are having a Rosary Procession Next Saturday, October 15 after the 5 pm Mass. Please join.

This weekend at all Masses, the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be administered to those who need it. The Anointing of the Sick and the Last Rite are different. They're distinct. Last Rites are the set of prayers and Sacramental activities that occur as someone is preparing to die, when it's pretty clear that a person is in the process of dying. The Anointing of the Sick is a Sacrament that is given for the healing (bodily healing and spiritual healing) of a person who is ill. It conveys several graces and imparts gifts of strengthening in the Holy Spirit against anxiety, discouragement, and temptation, and conveys peace and fortitude (CCC 1520).

Our Called to Renew Program is going well thanks to your generosity. I appreciate everybody who made the pledge already. I earnestly invite others to do the same. Let us share our blessings to build up His Body here who blessed us already.

I welcome all who are visiting our parish this weekend. My prayers and congratulations to those who celebrate birthdays or anniversaries of their weddings these days. May those who are sick get well and those who are mourning by the loss of a loved one find comfort and hope in Jesus.

CALIFORNIA VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1 Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions — for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.
