From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends.

Next Sunday is Christmas. Christmas is the most joyful time of the entire year. However, the 'Christmas Joy' did not come to Mary and Joseph easily. They went through a series of trials and tests. Their success was not that they stick with their plans, but they set aside their personal dreams and were open to the plan of God. "Do not be afraid." "Nothing is impossible for God." These statements from the Angel inspired them to replace their dreams with God's.

We have dreams and plans. At times they may not materialize. Unexpected twists can interrupt everything. Sickness, loss of a job and death can shake our faith and spread shadows on our way. When we feel like we reach a dead end, like Joseph and Mary, let us hear the comforting words of the Angel of God: "Do not be afraid. God is with us. He is Emanuel. Nothing is impossible for God."

As soon as she was filled with the Holy Spirit, the fearful Mary became a courageous woman and set out in a haste to help Elizabeth. Openness to the Holy Spirit is the key to joy.
