

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends.

"The Glory of God is fully human being fully alive." I love this statement. This saying is from St. Irenaeus. According to him, God is happy when we live our life completely. In fact, the purpose of the incarnation of Jesus was to heal the wounded humanity. Remember the saying of Jesus: "I have come so that you may have life and have it in abundance." (John 10/10).

We are living in a broken world. We have brokenness. Our brokenness not only impairs our life, but it breaks others too. Our inner conflict inflicts pain upon others. We do not need to live in brokenness in so far as there is a solution. How do we fix it? How can I restore my lost integrity? How can I live my life in its fullness?

The answer is 'walk with God'. Adam and Eve had fullness of life and they enjoyed complete joy when they walked with God. Their happiness vanished from them the moment they pushed God away from their life. They lost their center. Misery crept into their life.

The irony is that often times we do not know who controls our life. The devil is too smart that it presents vanity as if it is essential for happiness. Its tactics are very subtle but deceptive. It is difficult to discern deception from reality.

Jesus' method is the only way to discover our self. Go to the desert. In other words, spend time with God in solitude. God will reveal to us our inner pulls and interior conflicts. God is the mirror to see our heart. Jesus defeated the tricks of Satan using the Word of God.

Lent is a time of renewal for us individually and collectively. This year we are doing something special as a community. This Sunday (the first Sunday of Lent) every family gets a lighted purple candle along with a Lenten prayer. This candle reminds us of our identity. "We are a chosen people and God's special possession. We are chosen and called out of darkness into his wonderful light." (Peter 2:9). Please light the candle every evening and pray the Lenten Prayer.

Similarly, please do not miss Sunday Mass during Lent. If possible, attend daily Mass as well. Please attend the Stations of the Cross, Lenten Reflections (Wednesday evening) and Holy Hour on Fridays at 6 pm. During Holy Hour on Fridays, a priest will be available to hear confession. All these spiritual practices will help us to live our life fully. Remember the words of Jesus. "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." (John 15:11). Come let us grow together.

St. Francis Xavier Adult Confirmation

The Adult Confirmation process is for Catholics who have not received the sacrament of Confirmation, which completes their full initiation into the Catholic Church.

Confirmation This five week process emphasizes the basics of Catholic teaching and addresses concerns, questions and responsibilities. The last session is reconciliation (confession) with a priest in Church. Sessions are weekly, Thursday evenings at 6:30 in the Sunburst Room (across from the front entrance to the church).

Requirements for Adult Confirmation Preparation

- A Roman Catholic adult who has received first Eucharist
 - · A copy of Baptismal Certificate
 - One must select a Confirmation sponsor

Requirements for Sponsors

A sponsor must be a confirmed Catholic who lives their faith and is willing to accept the privilege of supporting their candidate during the Confirmation preparation and beyond
 A sponsor may not be the candidate's parent


