

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

This woman prayed every day: "Lord I am desperately in need of money. Help me to win a raffle". She said the same prayer every day. After being tired of praying, one day she yelled at God, "God, don't you care for me? You never helped me win a lottery". God said: Woman, I really care about you. I desperately wanted to help you, but you never bought a ticket.

We have dreams. God is there to help us. God promised Abraham a new land. Jesus showed three of his disciples a glimpse of heavenly life. God is always there for us.

How do we reach the 'promised land'? Our natural human tendency is to catch fish without wetting our hands. Peter said, "It is good to be here. We will right away build three houses here." God did not approve his proposal. Instead, God said to him, "Listen to Jesus." We are here not to make plans for God but to implement God's plan for us.

Abraham is our model in implementing God's plan. When God said, 'Go to a land that I will show you', he blindly obeyed Him. He was willing to give up his safety and security and left for the unknown land. His only security was his confidence in God. There is no free lunch. It is not enough to say 'Lord, Lord' but we need to live the Word in our daily life. Paul says, "God saved us not according to our works, but according to His own design. Therefore, bear our share of hardships for the Gospel."

How eagerly we are listening to the word of God and how excited we are to implement his plan in our life. We have ample opportunities during this holy season of Lent to experience 'Transfiguration' in our life. Please attend the Stations of the Cross, Lenten reflections (Enlightening Encounter) and enjoy the Lenten soup on Wednesdays (events starting at 5:30 pm). Please try to spend one hour with Jesus on Fridays (Holy Hour 6 pm to 7 pm). You can celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at the same time too. I invite you to watch and listen to our YouTube presentation on Mondays: Chosen to Serve.

Lent is a time for renewal. Remember: "We are a chosen people and God's special possession. We are chosen and called out of darkness into his wonderful light." (Peter 2:9). Let us always be mindful of our identity. Let us celebrate our identity celebrating the Holy Eucharist every Sunday without taking exception.
