

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Happy Easter. I wish you and your family Joy and Hope.

Hope is the foundation for survival. A person without hope goes to sleep wishing for an endless sunset. The death of Jesus shattered the dreams of his disciples. The saying of Jesus 'it is finished' echoed in their ears as a frightening voice. Mary Magdalena went to the tomb of Jesus not with any expectation. Her heart was full of frustration, anger and grief. Her heart was full of emptiness. God is God of surprise. An Angel appeared to Mary Magdalena and said, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen!"
