

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. In 1930, Jesus appeared to Faustina, a Polish Nun, and revealed to her the nature of God's love. Jesus said to her: "My love is unlimited and available to all, especially to the poor sinners." St. Pope John Paul II advised the Universal Church to celebrate the Divine Mercy of God in a special way on the first Sunday after Easter.

The whole Bible is a series of stories that proclaim the merciful love of God towards humanity. The Evangelist John beautifully summarized the depth and width of God's love in the following statement: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (John 3:16).

Jesus started his ministry declaring, "I desire Mercy not sacrifice, I haven't come to call the righteous but sinners." (Matthew 9:13). The readings for the second Sunday of Easter further substantiates this point. The Gospel (John 20:19-29) talks about two specific actions of Jesus that reflect his mercy and compassion.

When Jesus appeared to the disciples for the first time after his resurrection, he did not bring up the past. He did not scold Peter for denying Him on the way to Calvary. Instead, he said to them: "Peace be with you." Jesus offered them peace and reconciliation. Jesus showed the same mercy towards Thomas too. When Thomas was reluctant to believe in the resurrection, Jesus came to him, showed his wounded hands, and satisfied his desire in the way Thomas wanted.

Mercy is not only about forgiving those who do us harm or those who offend. Mercy also has to do with self-sacrifice and charity to neighbors as well. Mercy operates on two levels: a corporal level and a spiritual level. For example, the corporal works of mercy are as follows: To feed the hungry; To give drink to the thirsty; To clothe the naked; To provide shelter for the homeless; To visit the sick; To ransom the captive; To bury the dead.

An important way of growing in the virtue of mercy is meditating on the mercy of God. This Sunday at 2 pm, we are having Divine Mercy Adoration in the church. Please come with your family and friends.

May God bless you.
