From the Desk of Fr. Sebastían,

Dear Friends,

One of the most popular Easter stories is the story of the Emmaus Journey. This incident teaches us the basic principles of Christian Spirituality.

First, it talks about a caring God; a God who goes after the lost sheep. The death of Jesus shattered disciple's hope. They did not wait to see his resurrection. They started leaving the city of Jerusalem one by one.

Though the disciples gave up on Jesus, Jesus did not give up on them. Like a good shepherd, he searched for them. He met them wherever they were. He brought them back to Jerusalem. We cannot hide from God's eyes. The Psalmist says: "Where can I flee from your presence? If I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me; your right hand will hold me fast." (Ps 139).

Secondly, the two disciples recognized the Risen Lord in the breaking of the Word and the breaking of the Bread. Recount the story "While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. Then they said to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?" So, they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem.

What does it say to us? We encounter Jesus at the altar of the church today. There are two altars in the church. The altar of the Word and the altar of the Bread. The altar of the Word illuminates us to recognize Jesus' presence on the altar of the Bread.

Jesus is looking after you. Come to the altar. Receive the Holy Eucharist and walk with Jesus. Then, "even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you." (Ps 139: 12).

For the same reason, ministry at and around the altar (liturgical ministry) is a great source of blessing. Over the next several weekends you will hear from different liturgical ministries. Sign up to join one ministry or the other.

This Sunday is a day of blessing for the community. 33 teens and 5 adults are receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at 1 pm from Bishop Wilkerson. On behalf of SFX Community, I congratulate them and pray for the gifts of the Holy Spirit upon them. I am very grateful to Deacon Jim, Rosie and their Team for helping these young people for this all-important day. Their hard work, commitment and love for the Church is commendable. Thank you Dn. Jim and Team. Please note that because of the Holy Mass for the Sacrament of Confirmation at 1 pm, there will not be our regular Sunday 11:30 am Mass on this Sunday. Sorry for your inconvenience.

May the Risen Lord continue to bless you.


