# From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

Today is Trinity Sunday. While every other feast of the Church year refers to an event – Jesus' birth, baptism, resurrection, etc., the day of the Holy Trinity is one where we commemorate a doctrine. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity is worshiping one God in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. "We do not confess three gods, but one God in three persons." (CCC- 253). They are three persons, but one nature, one God, equal, undivided, and no separation. This is a mystery of faith. "It is the central mystery of Christian faith and life." (CCC- 234).

Our Faith in the Holy Trinity was founded on the scripture and the Divine Revelation. The idea of the Trinity is completely manifested at the time of Jesus' baptism.

Since it is a difficult reality to comprehend with finite human intellect, what is important for us is focusing on the message of the Holy Trinity than the doctrine itself. The message of the Trinity is a message of Love. As St Catherine reminded us, we are inside the mystery of God, not outside. We no longer have to look 'up there' or 'out there' for God as if he was a million miles away. Through Incarnation, (Jesus) God is with us and through Pentecost (Holy Spirit) God is within us. We are in God and God is in us.

Baptism inserts us into this circle of the life of the Trinity where we share the life of God. Every time we bless ourselves, we remind ourselves of a great truth that changes everything. If I am inside the Trinity, I am never alone. I belong to God, and I belong to His people.

Since the Trinity is communion of love (relationship), to enter the mystery of Trinity, we need to be in communion with one another. Relationship becomes a means of receiving divine grace. This realization must motivate us to become an active member of God's family. This family is our parish. We live a shared life, which is why we share the Eucharist together. This is the shared life we live in the Trinity and that we celebrate at every Mass. And next Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi. We will have benediction after the 10 am Mass.

Let the Spirit of the Holy Trinity inspire us to live our life in its fullness. Our Pentecost celebration was a great experience. Thank you everyone for making it beautiful by your active participation. I congratulate all ministers who were commissioned last weekend. May God bless your generosity.

On behalf of our Parish community, I congratulate the graduates of our school. Dear students start your next stage in life with the light of Jesus. I wish you success and God's blessings.

Our Old Tyme Country Faire is this coming weekend. Please come, enjoy, and make it a great success. This is another way of practicing our unity and that is the message of the Holy Trinity.
