From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

This Tuesday is the 4th of July. It is our Independence Day. Naturally, this week we reflect about freedom. We talk about Political freedom, economic freedom, intellectual freedom, freedom of expression, freedom of worship and so forth. They all are important. What is freedom after all?

Generally speaking: Freedom is the ability to choose without restriction from our choices. However, is this really freedom? I have seen people who are financially rich but are a slave to money. I have seen leaders who are in authority but are a slave to power. I have also seen people who are literally poor but are joyful and happy. Then what is freedom after all? Who is free? Jesus has the answer. He says, "You will know the truth and truth will set you free." (John 8:32). In other words, we are free when we walk with Jesus who is the way, the life, and the truth.

When we center our life on the Creator then we are free. On the other hand, when we center our existence on creatures or created things, then we are a slave. Freedom requires a God guiding conscience. Conscience is God's voice within us. Freedom without reference to God is slavery. This was the mistake of our first parents.

On this day, let us thank God for the political and religious freedom we enjoy and pray for God's special blessings on the leaders and the people of our country. On this day, let us pray for each one of us that we respect the freedom of others and use our own freedom responsibly.
