# From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

## Dear Friends,

There is a story of a boy and his grandfather walking along the beach. The beach was covered with starfish that had been washed ashore. Every so often, the grandfather would stop, pick up one of the starfish, and toss it back into the ocean. After a while the little boy said to his grandfather, "There are thousands of starfish on the beach. Throwing a few back into the ocean can't possibly make a difference." As the grandfather tossed another starfish into the ocean, he said, "It makes a difference to that one."

Every Eucharistic celebration ends with this commissioning: Go in peace to love and serve the Lord. When Jesus told his disciples, "You are the light of the world," he meant it. We have a mandate to "go and make a difference in the world."

This invitation of Jesus is even more important today as evil is growing rapidly in our society more than ever. The existence of evil, for whatever reason, is real. We cannot uproot it all together. So, what is the solution? I can change my part of the world. This is possible because the kingdom of God is within me.

The Kingdom of God (the grace of God) is in every person. It may be as small as a mustard seed, but it has the potential to grow big. Think about the story of St. Teresa of Calcutta. She was an ordinary person like any of us. However, she recognized the "mustard seed of compassion" in her heart. She did not ignore it. She let it grow. As a result, she became a universal symbol of compassion.

It is easy to blame the existence of evil. Blame does not solve the problem. As the parable says, leave them to God. Let Him take care of it. Our challenge is to recognize the mustard seed in each one of us, stay away from the seeds of weeds and prepare the spiritual environment for its growth. Jesus resisted evil by using the word of God. The word of God can enlighten us, guide us and inspire us. Read the Bible every day. Get familiarized with it.

This weekend we have the opportunity to make a difference in the people of the Diocese of Nyundo in Rwanda by supporting their missionary work. Fr. Bosco will preach at all masses and make an appeal for their mission. Let us be generous with our financial support.

July 30, 2023 – Human Trafficking Awareness Day Red Sand Project – after 10:00 a.m. Mass

Human trafficking is a multi-billion-dollar criminal industry that steals freedom from more than 25 million people around the world. In some cases, traffickers trick, defraud or physically force victims into selling sex. In others, victims are lied to, assaulted, threatened or manipulated into working under inhumane, illegal or otherwise unacceptable conditions.

The Red Sand Project is an interactive activity designed to raise awareness on human trafficking. By spreading red sand in sidewalks cracks, brings attention to the millions who have "fallen through the cracks" in society. The Peace & Justice Ministry invites you to join its members to spread red sand in the cracks of the Church's parking lot on July 30th after the 10:00 a.m. Mass in solidarity with the victims and the survivors of human trafficking.

# St. Francis Xavier Parish Religious Education Programs REGISTER TODAY - CLASSES BEGIN LATE SEPTEMBER

**SUNDAY SCHOOL:** Do you have a little one entering Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten in the Fall? (ages 4, 5, 6) St. Francis has a Sunday School program designed just for them which meets during the 10:00 A.M. Mass. Using music, storytelling and crafts this program is designed to nurture young children's natural tendency to seek a relationship with God, reinforcing a strong sense of community and love.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION GRADES 1-5: This program has been designed specifically for children of public or non-Catholic private schools, and presents religious education and sacramental preparation information in a fun and innovative way. Baptized children generally begin their Sacramental Preparation in the first grade, and make the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the 2nd grade. However, we enroll children 1st through 5th grade for this program. (If your child is in the 6th grade or above, please contact our religious education office for class information at 818-504-4411). Classes run Sept. through early May on Wednesdays from 3:45-5:00 P.M.



Religious Education For Grades 3,4,5: Catholic education continues past the child's First Communion. There are many more truths and traditions of Catholicism to be learned. Leading 3rd thru 5th graders in making moral choices and exploring an expanding faith through Gospel dramatizations, current events and original stories linked to the Gospel and kids' own lives. Saints' lives and imaginative activities demonstrate applications of the Gospel message, and "think" questions reinforce doctrinal concepts. These classes run from Sept. through mid May and meet on Wednesdays from 3:45 pm. to 5:00 pm.



CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (For children in the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Grade): In addition to your child's regular religious education instruction, this program runs late Sept. thru April during the Sunday 10:00 A.M. Mass and is a great opportunity for children to understand the Sunday Gospel at their own age level. After the opening prayer, the children are dismissed to a classroom in the lower school building. They are provided with colorful activities and handouts that enhance what they hear from their adult leaders about the word of God. The children then return to church to

celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the rest of the parish family. This is a free program and no registration is required.

**CONFIRMATION (for high schoolers):** Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. Led by Dn. Jim Roope and Confirmation Team Members, St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this Sacrament. It is designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school years, although most start as freshmen.



**ADULT CONFIRMATION (for adults over 21 years of age):** Led by Dn. Tony Hobbs, the Adult Confirmation program is held during Lent 2023. If you attend the required sessions, have been baptized, received first communion and attend Mass weekly, you will be ready to be Confirmed.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN—Led by Ms. Paula Lucero and RCIA Team Members. Are you yourself interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation? We have an excellent program for you - it is called the RCIA. The St. Francis Xavier parish community invites you meet with members of the RCIA team who welcome your interest and questions regarding the Catholic Church and our parish community.

Initiating Children (ages 7-17) Children's initiation is usually a two-year process by which children become Catholic. Some of the children who participate have not been baptized, and so these children will prepare for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist. Some of the children who participate have already been baptized in a church other than Catholic and they will prepare for First Eucharist, Penance and Confirmation in the Church. If a child is baptized Catholic, entering 6th grade or above and has not made First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, they also belong in RCIA.



The same is true of abuse victims — there is no demographic "failsafe," such as age, race, gender, background, income, etc., that prevents a certain person from being abused.
