

From the Desk of Fr. Sebastian,

Dear Friends,

A group of people from a different religion came to visit my church when I was working as a missionary priest in the Himalayan region of North India. In those days, the Christian population in North India was significantly low. The visitors were completely shocked to see the crucifix. "Is this your God? Why are you worshiping a defeated God? Come to our Temple! Our Gods are heroes," they commented while leaving the church.

No one desires a life of sacrifice. Even Peter dissuaded Jesus from taking up the cross. Life devoid of sacrifice leads us to empty victories. The way of Jesus is the way of the cross. Jesus made it clear when he said, "Truly I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a seed; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. Whoever loves his life will lose it, but whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life...."

No one desires sacrifice but no one reaches greatness without sacrifice. We are the fruits of the sacrifices of our ancestors. Think about the sacrifices of your parents. Similarly, think about the sacrifices of great people. Think about the disciplined life of heroes in sports and games. "Great achievement is usually born of great sacrifice and is never the result of selfishness."

The word sacrifice is made up of two words: sacri and ficio, which means to make holy. When we make sacrifices, we raise ourselves to a higher level; we are bringing ourselves closer to our Creator and we are sanctifying our actions. Sacrifice is a miraculous, holy, and heroic investment in the future and a step towards greatness.

Sacrifice is not about loss but about gain. "Personal sacrifice for our own improvement is a holy act, but sacrificing for others, for their enrichment, as a parent does for a child, is the holiest of acts." We cannot follow Jesus without embracing the virtue of sacrifice. He said, "If anyone wants to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." Sacrifice can be a suffering if we face it without love. Suffering for a noble purpose makes it a sacrifice; a sacrament of grace, something divine and salvific.

Please attend a workshop on prayer this Tuesday, September 5 at 7 pm in the Cabrini Hall. I will discuss about different methods of prayer that bring us closer to God. Also, it is time to register your children for Religious Education and Confirmation programs.

SUNDAY SCHOOL: Do you have a little one entering Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten in the Fall? (ages 4, 5, 6) St. Francis has a Sunday School program designed just for them which meets during the 10:00 A.M. Mass. Using music, storytelling and crafts this program is designed to nurture young children's natural tendency to seek a relationship with God, reinforcing a strong sense of community and love.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION GRADES 1-5: This program has been designed specifically for children of public or non-Catholic private schools, and presents religious education and sacramental preparation information in a fun and innovative way. Baptized children generally begin their Sacramental Preparation in the first grade, and make the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the 2nd grade. However, we enroll children 1st through 5th grade for this program. (If your child is in the 6th grade or above, please contact our religious education office for class information at 818-504-4411). Classes run Sept. through early May on Wednesdays from 3:45-5:00 P.M.



Religious Education For Grades 3,4,5: Catholic education continues past the child's First Communion. There are many more truths and traditions of Catholicism to be learned. Leading 3rd thru 5th graders in making moral choices and exploring an expanding faith through Gospel dramatizations, current events and original stories linked to the Gospel and kids' own lives. Saints' lives and imaginative activities demonstrate applications of the Gospel message, and "think" questions reinforce doctrinal concepts. These classes run from Sept. through mid May and meet on Wednesdays from 3:45 pm. to 5:00 pm.



CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (For children in the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Grade): In addition to your child's regular religious education instruction, this program runs late Sept. thru April during the Sunday 10:00 A.M. Mass and is a great opportunity for children to understand the Sunday Gospel at their own age level. After the opening prayer, the children are dismissed to a classroom in the lower school building. They are provided with colorful activities and handouts that enhance what they hear from their adult leaders about the word of God. The children then return to church to

celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the rest of the parish family. This is a free program and no registration is required.

CONFIRMATION (for high schoolers): Confirmation is the final Sacrament of Initiation that brings your teen into full communion with the church. Led by Dn. Jim Roope and Confirmation Team Members, St. Francis Xavier follows a two-year preparation process for reception of this Sacrament. It is designed to help our young people come to a deeper understanding of how the Holy Spirit works in our lives and in the life of the Church. Boys and girls begin the process anytime in their high school years, although most start as freshmen.



ADULT CONFIRMATION (for adults over 21 years of age): Led by Dn. Tony Hobbs, the Adult Confirmation program is held during Lent 2023. If you attend the required sessions, have been baptized, received first communion and attend Mass weekly, you will be ready to be Confirmed.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN—Led by Ms. Paula Lucero and RCIA Team Members. Are you yourself interested in becoming baptized in the Catholic Church, or completing your sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation? We have an excellent program for you - it is called the RCIA. The St. Francis Xavier parish community invites you meet with members of the RCIA team who welcome your interest and guestions regarding the Catholic Church and our parish community.

Initiating Children (ages 7-17) Children's initiation is usually a two-year process by which children become Catholic. Some of the children who participate have not been baptized, and so these children will prepare for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist. Some of the children who participate have already been baptized in a church other than Catholic and they will prepare for First Eucharist, Penance and Confirmation in the Church. If a child is baptized Catholic, entering 6th grade or above and has not made First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, they also belong in RCIA.


